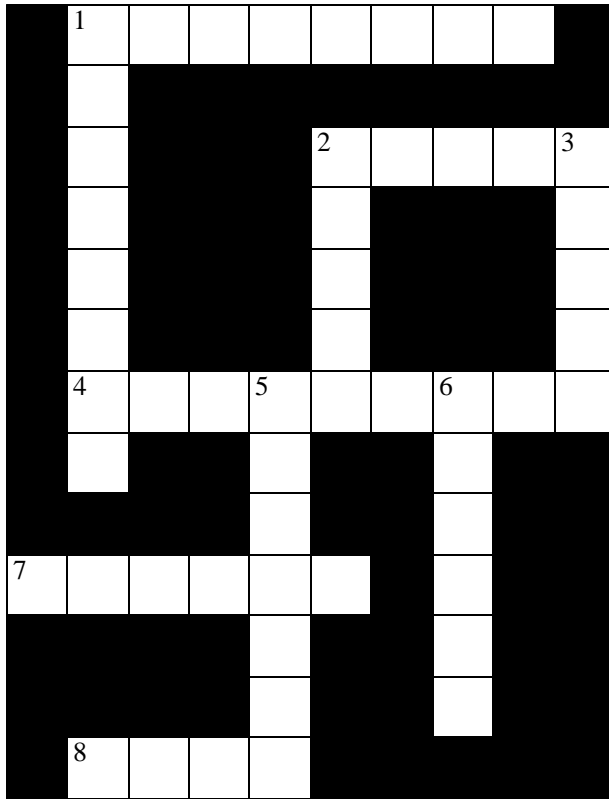


# Burning Bush
