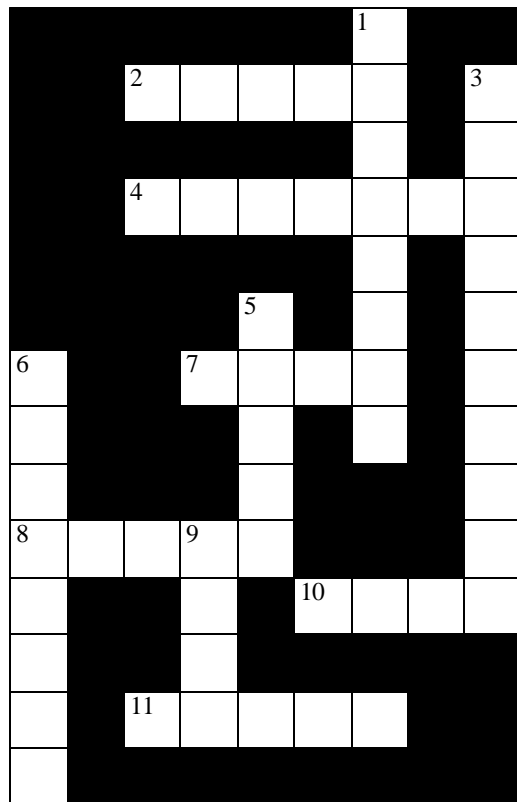


Jerusalem Destroyed
