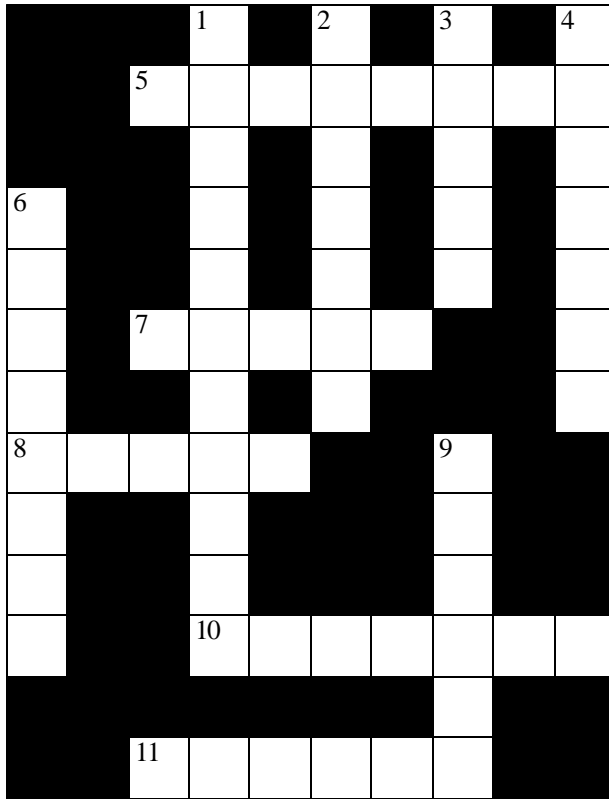


# Rebecca
