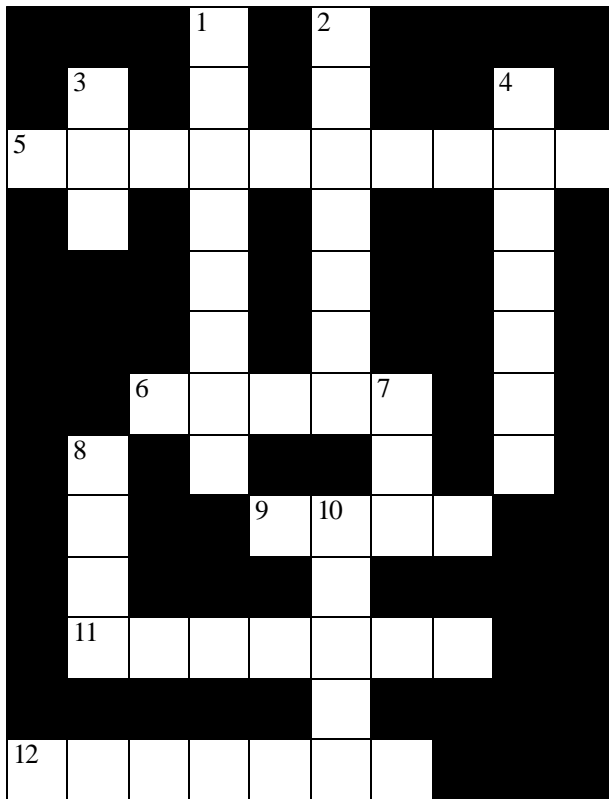


# Samuel
