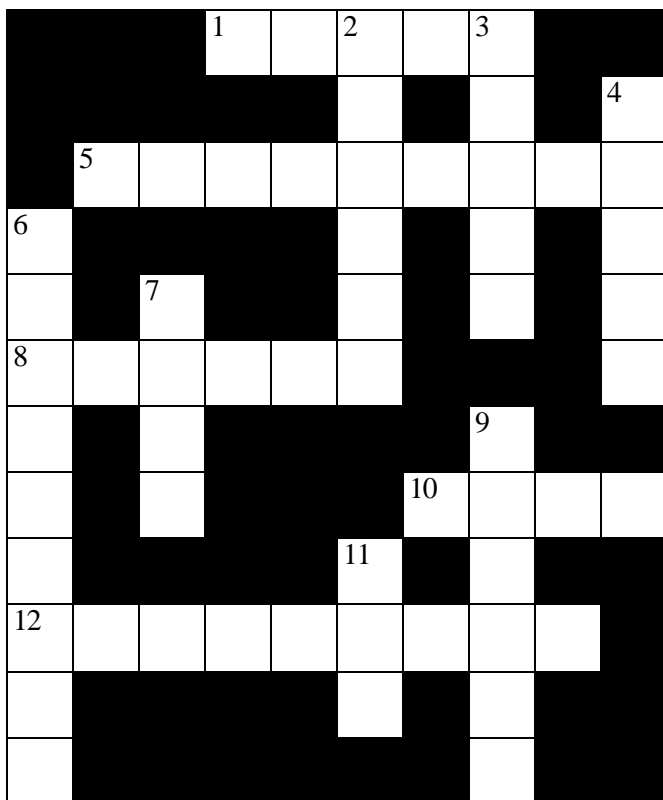


Shepherd David
