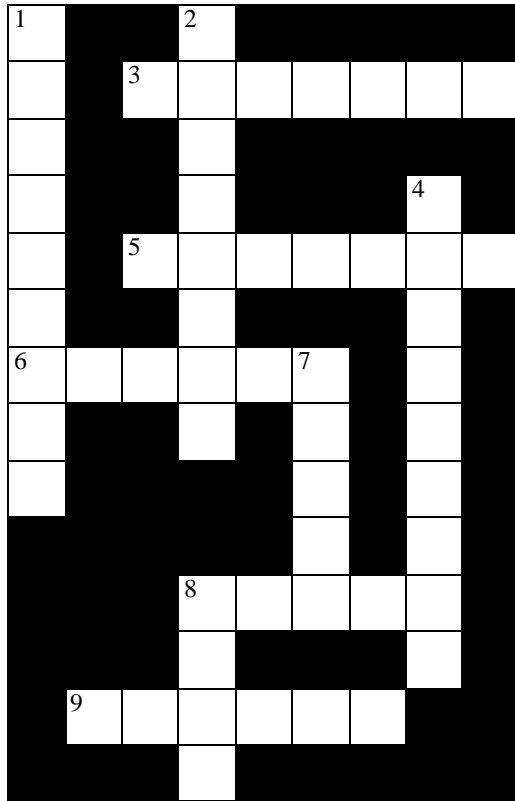


# Anointing Jesus
