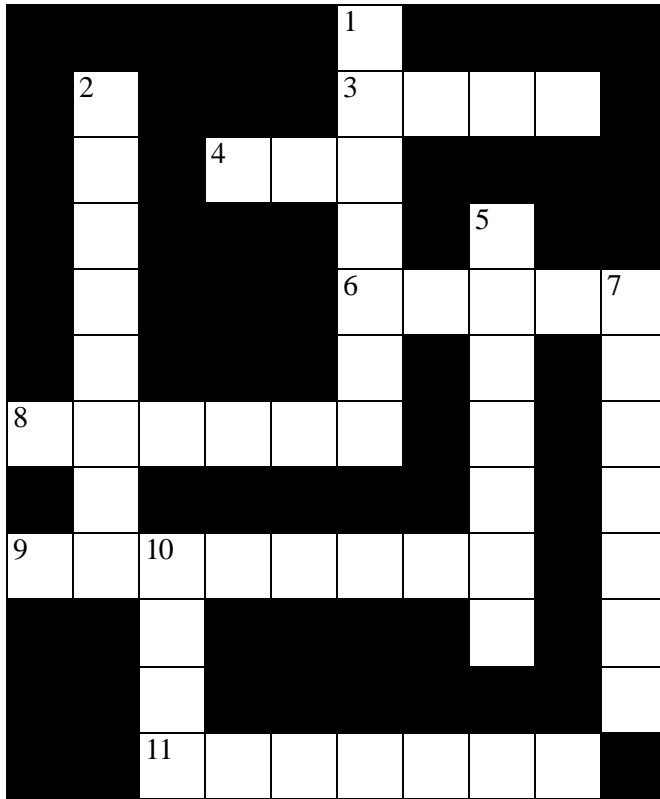


# Sermon on the Mount
