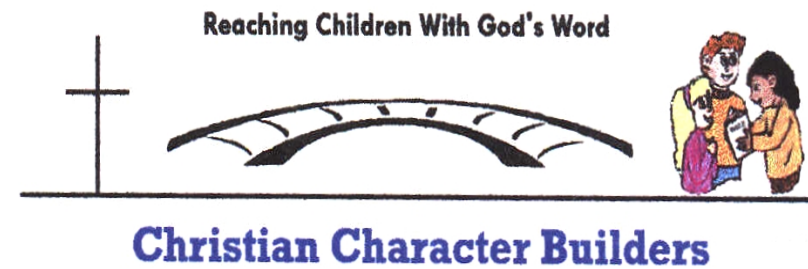

So come as you are, but come expecting to meet and worship our risen Lord, Jesus Christ.

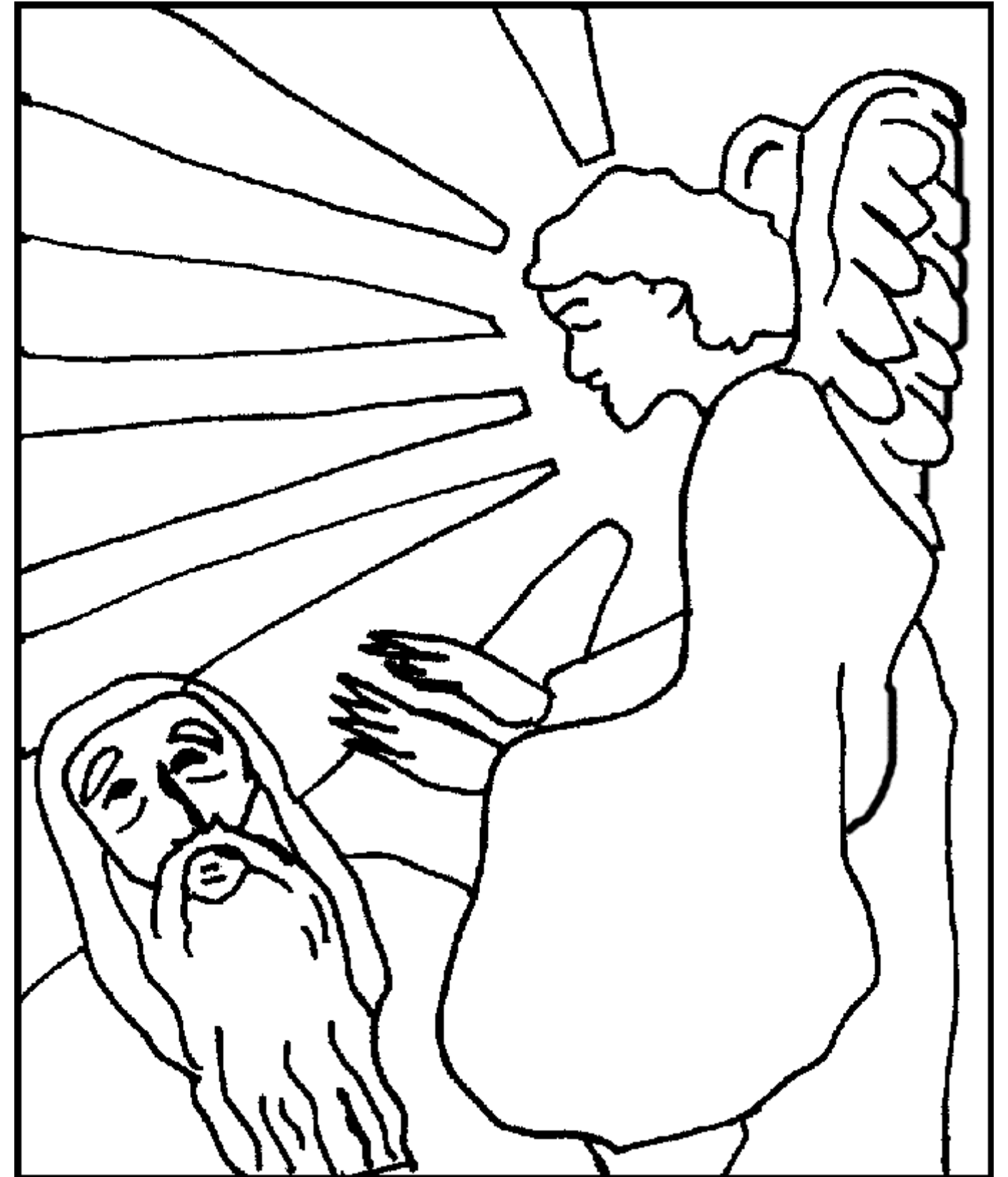

### God's invitation to you

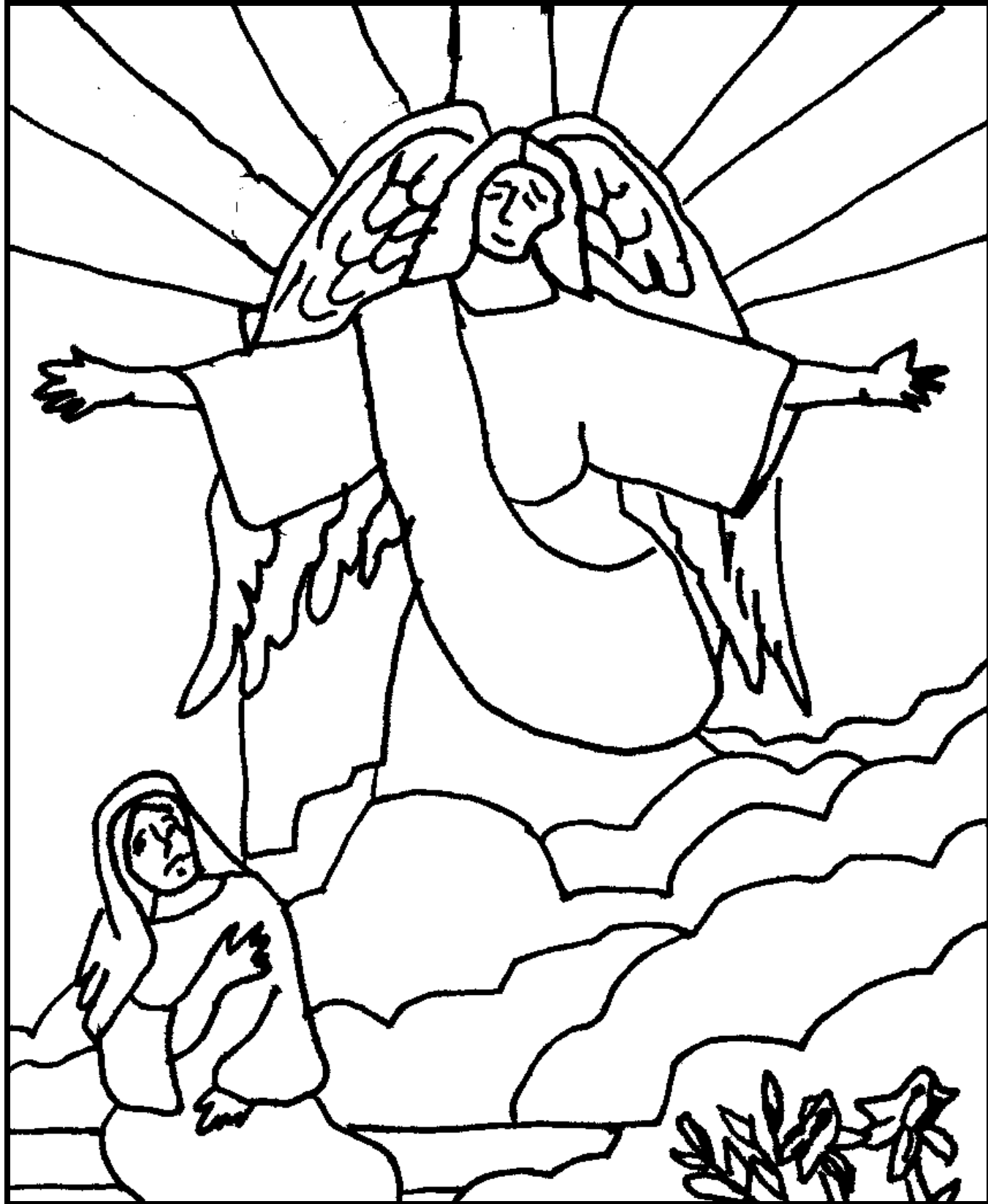
The most important thing you will ever do is surrender your life to Jesus. Yet so many Christians do not understand God's plan. Whether you need to take these steps yourself, or understand them to share with others, it is crucial that we understand God's plan for man ...

- G** – God created us to have a relationship with Him (Gen. 3:8-9)
- O** – Our sin separates us from God (Romans 3:23, Isaiah 1:4-9)
- S** – Sin cannot be overcome by good works (Gal 2:16)
- P** – Paying the price for sin, Jesus died on the cross (Matt 20:28)
- E** – Everyone who places their faith in Jesus will have life eternal (John 3:16)
- L** – Life eternal begins now, being illustrated by a life lived for Jesus and a desire to follow His commands (James 2:14-20)

and shalt call his name JESUS!



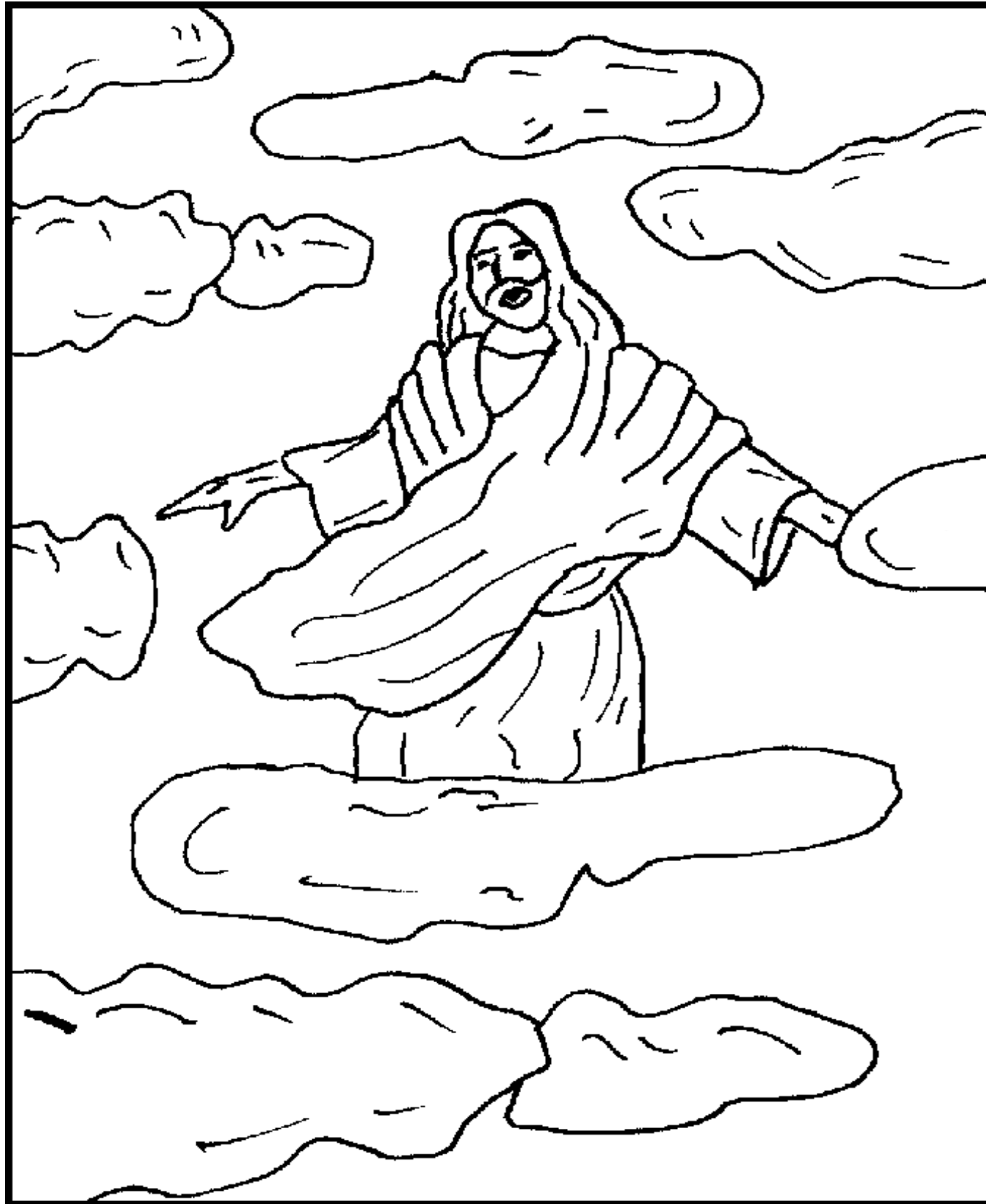

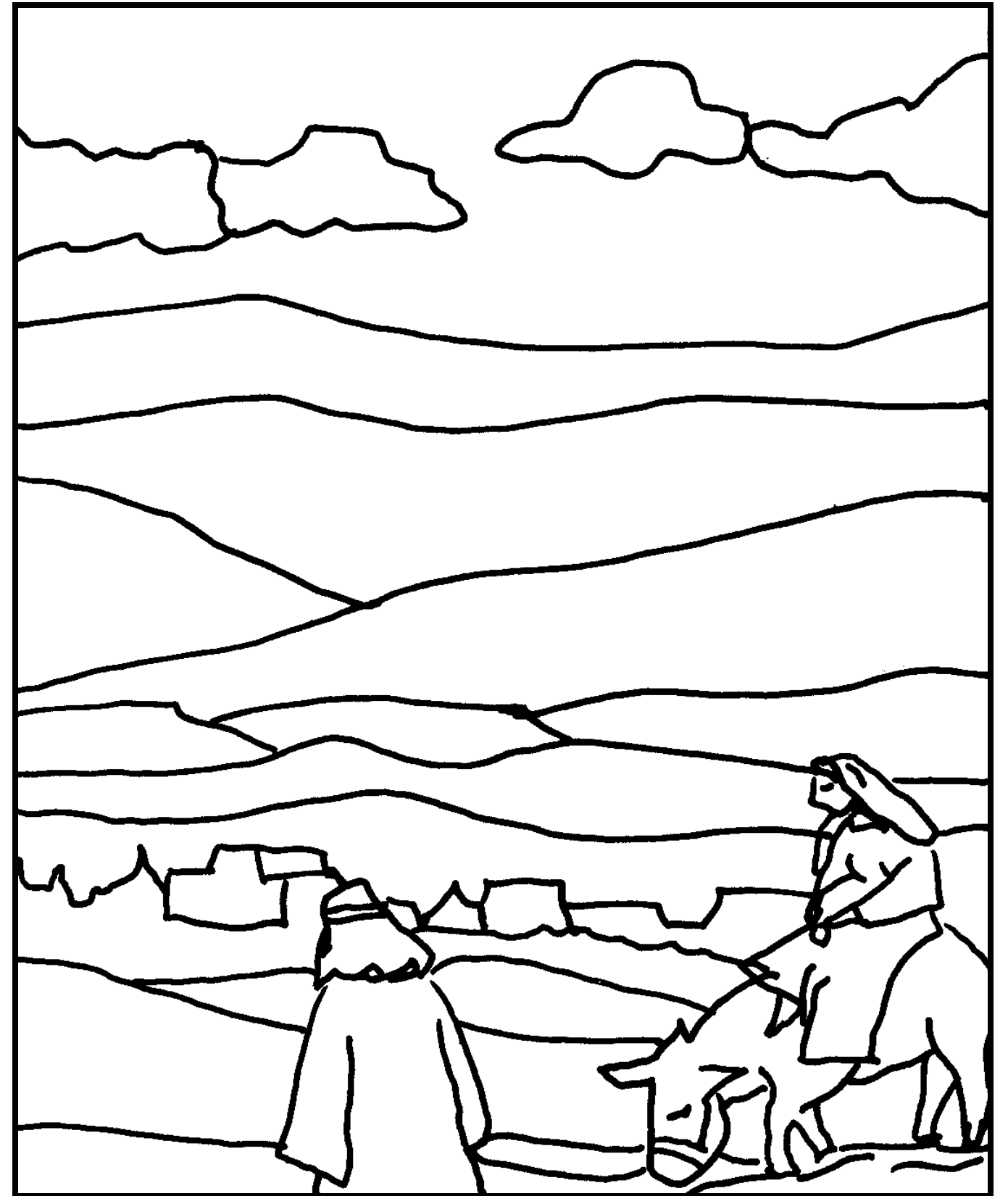
## Ascension Luke 24:45-53

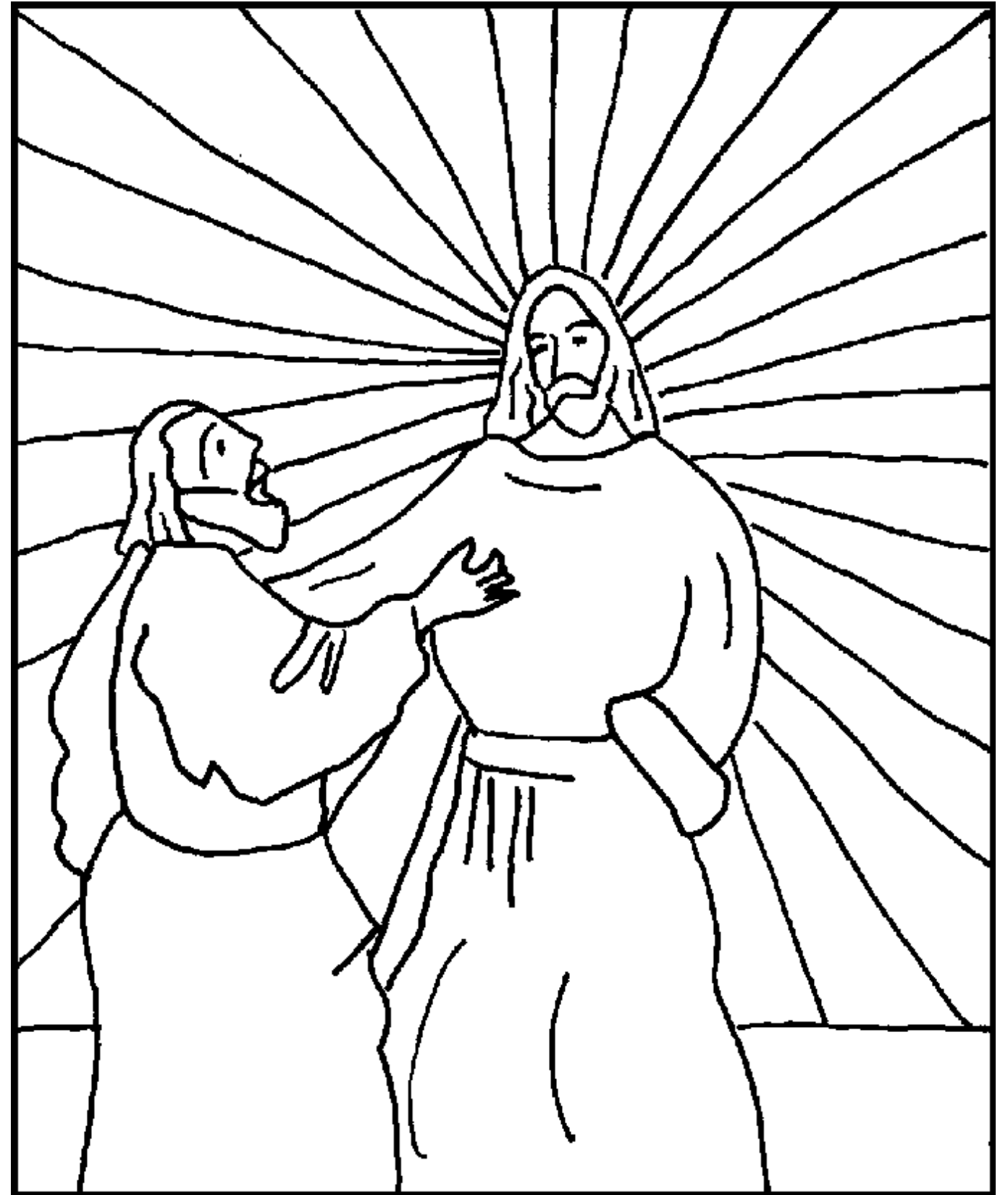

Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.



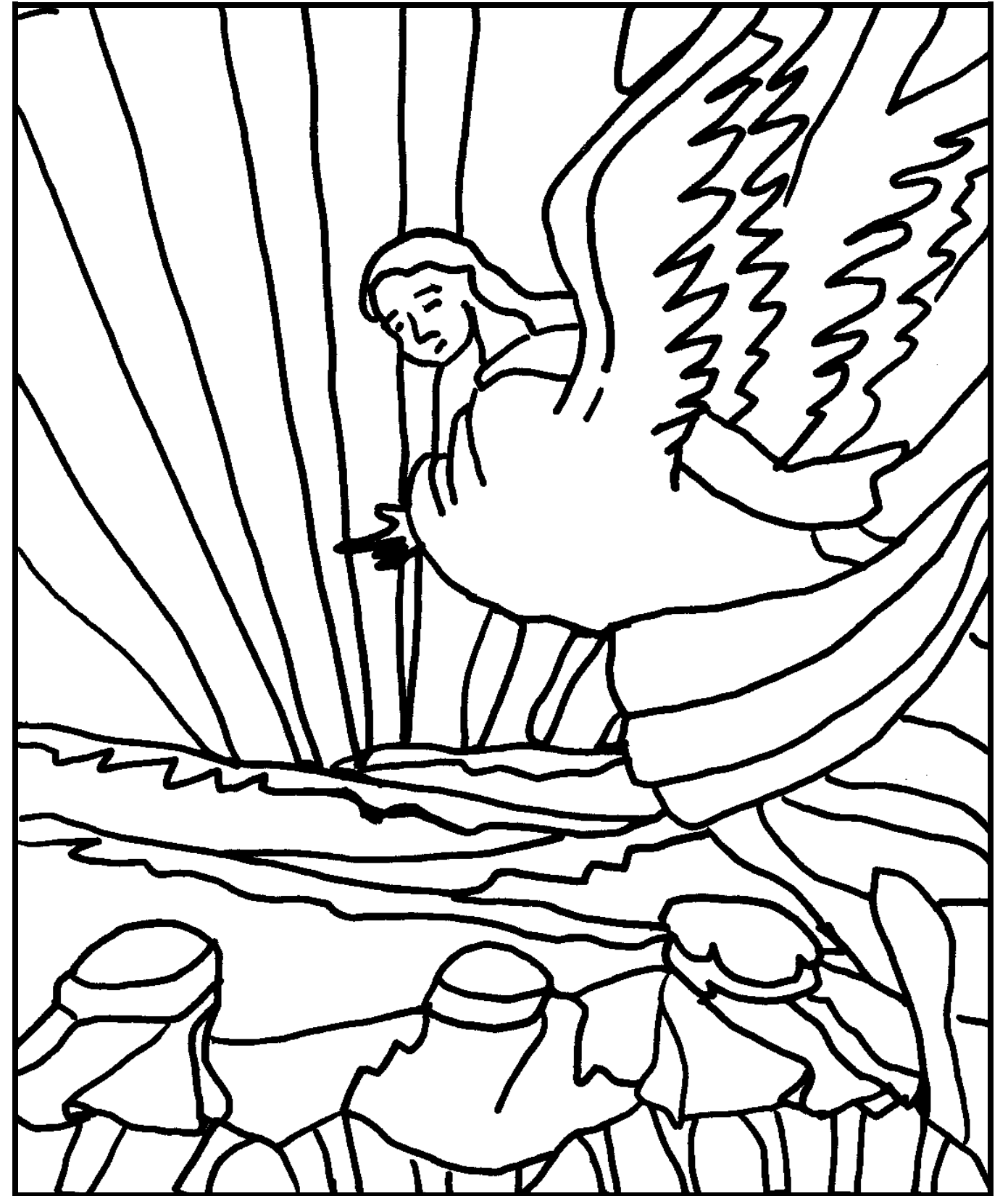

And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it.



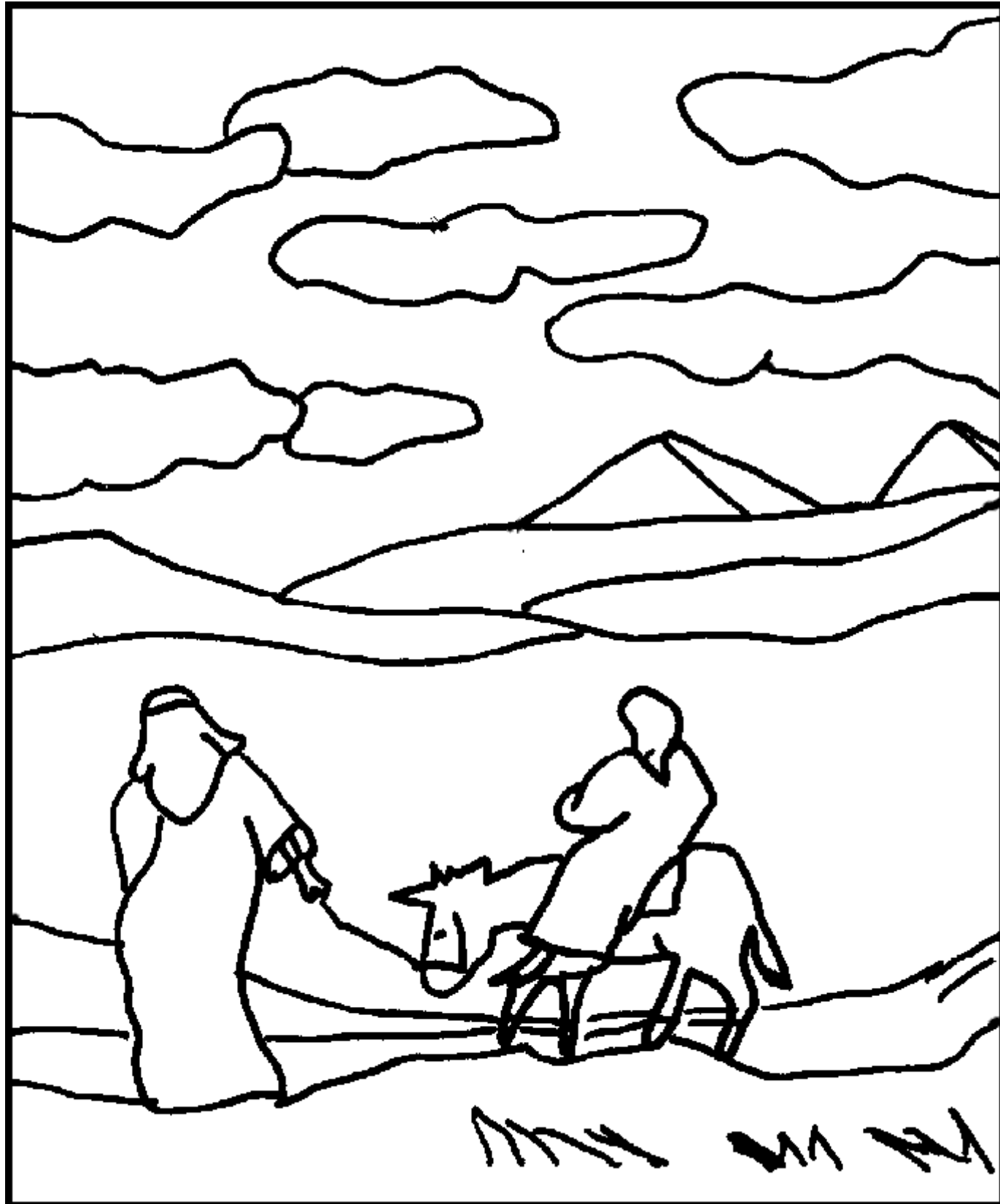

And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt.



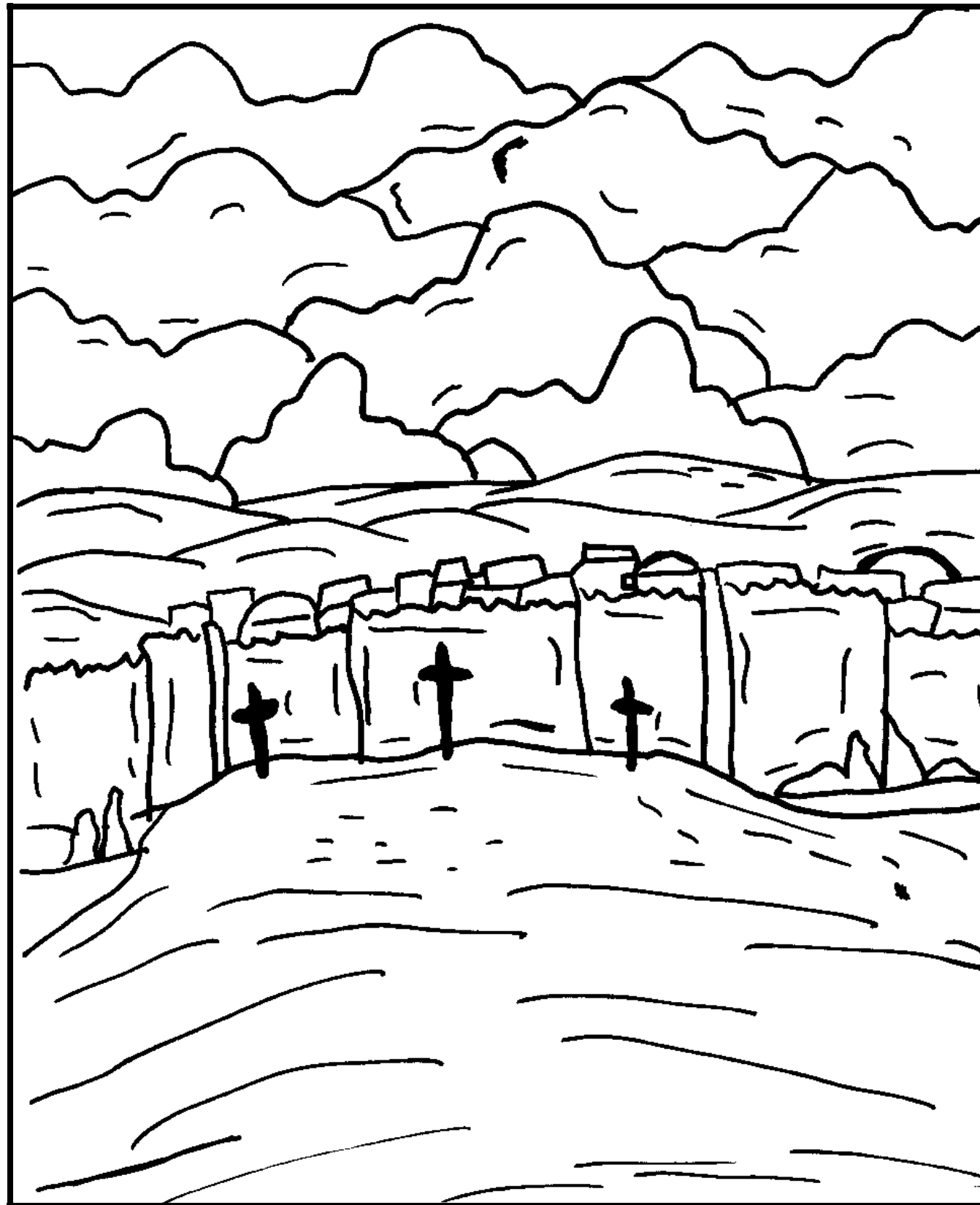
# Jesus' Burial John 19:38-42

Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.



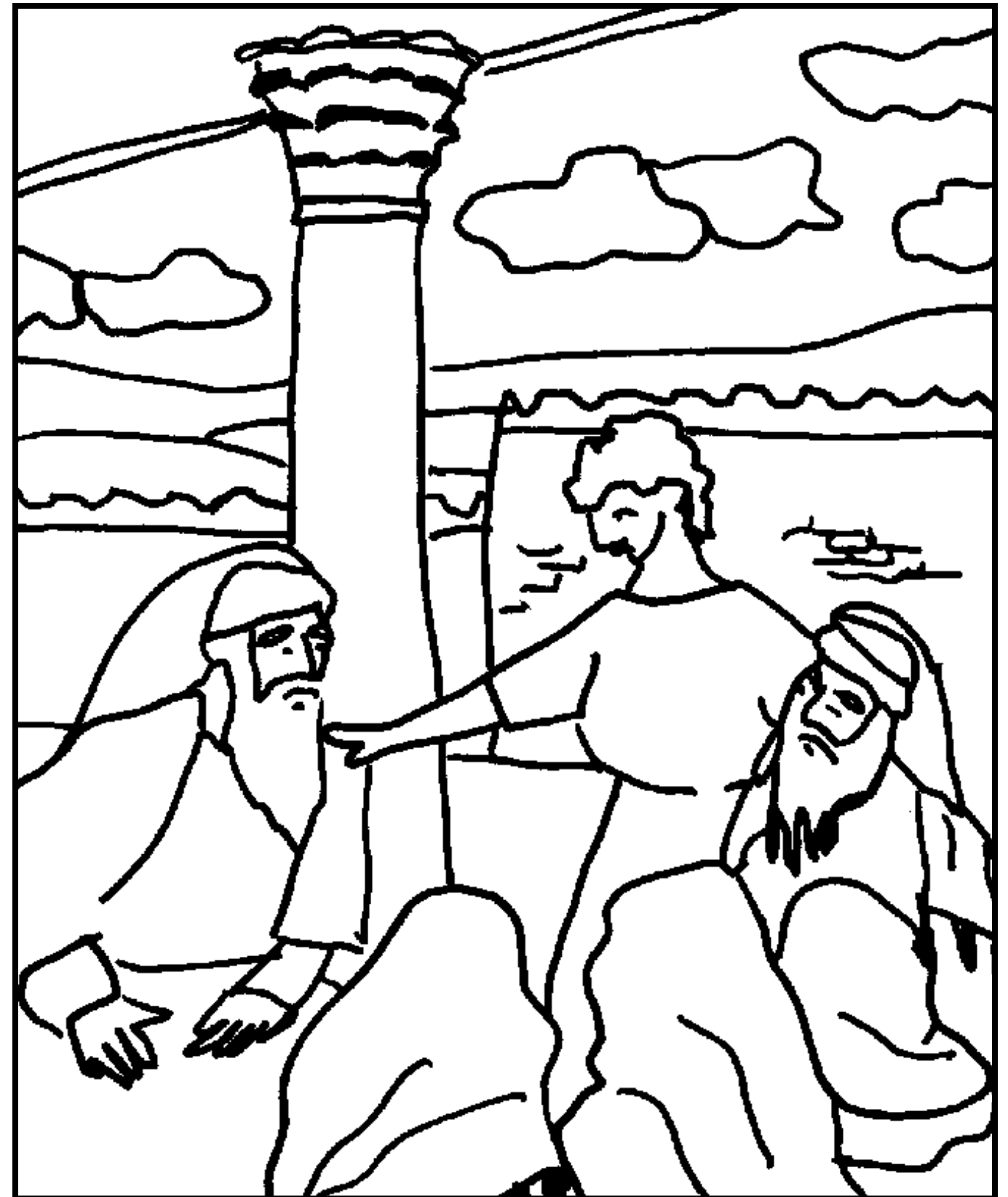

For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken. And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced.



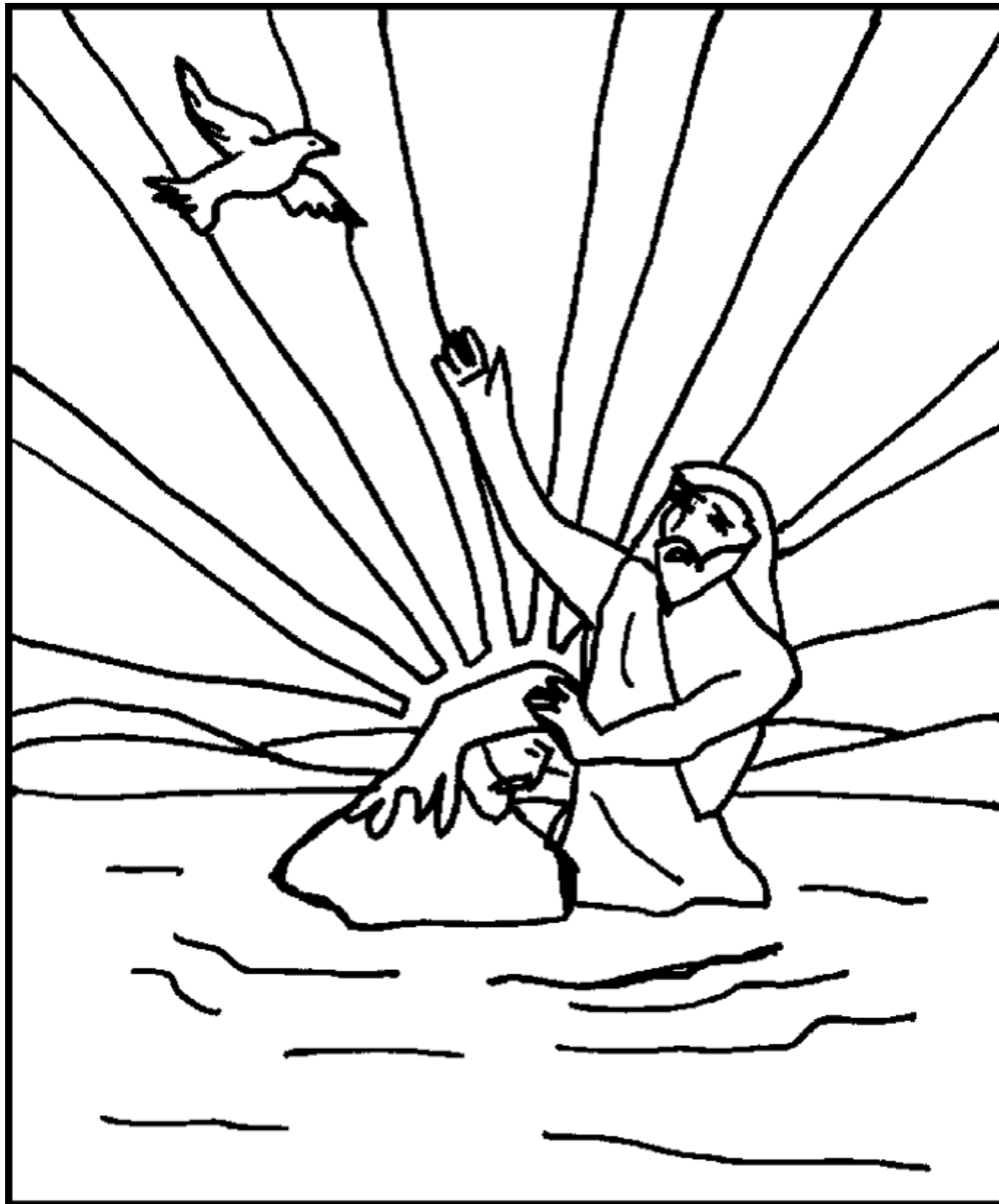

and his disciples believed on him.



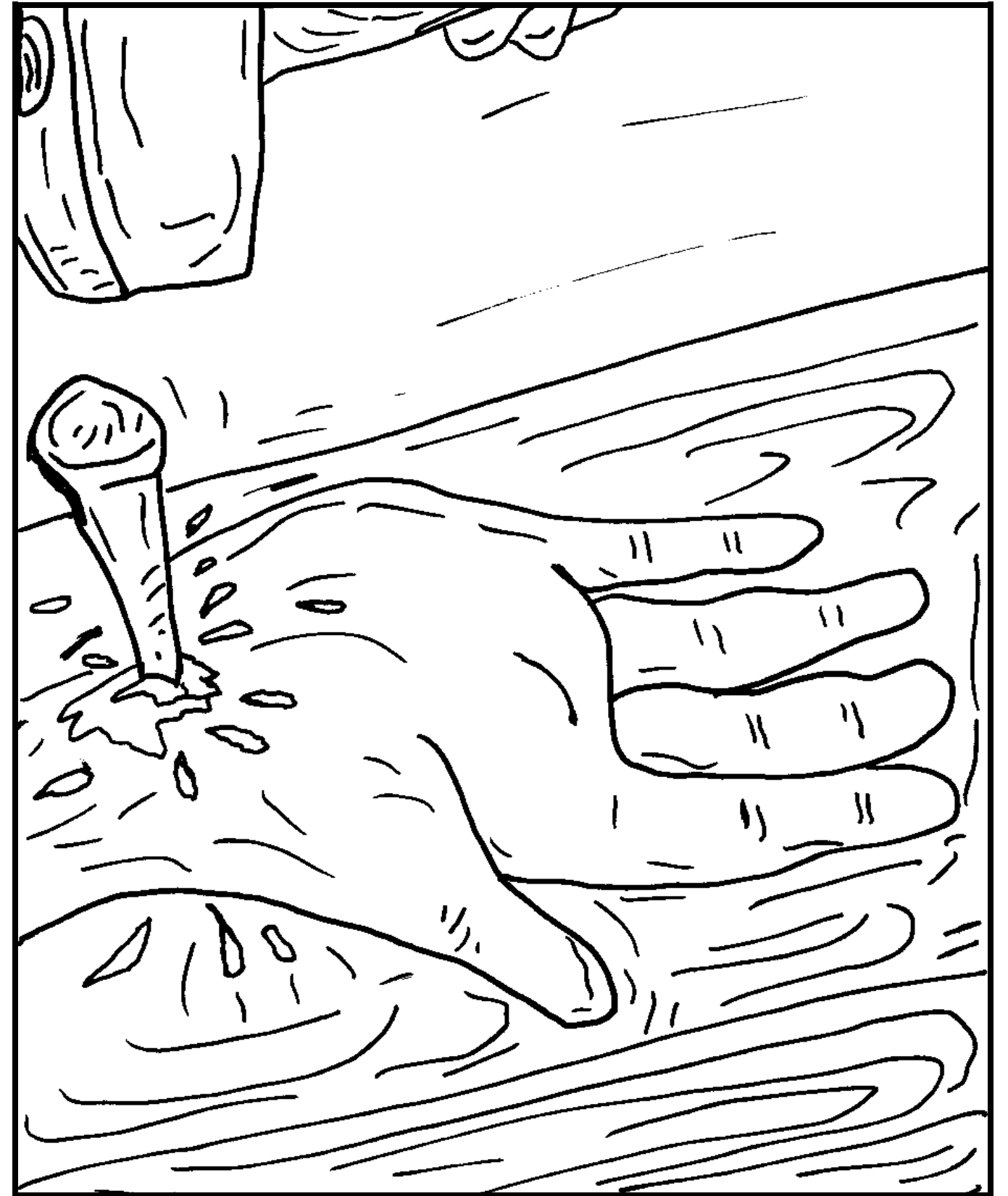

Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst



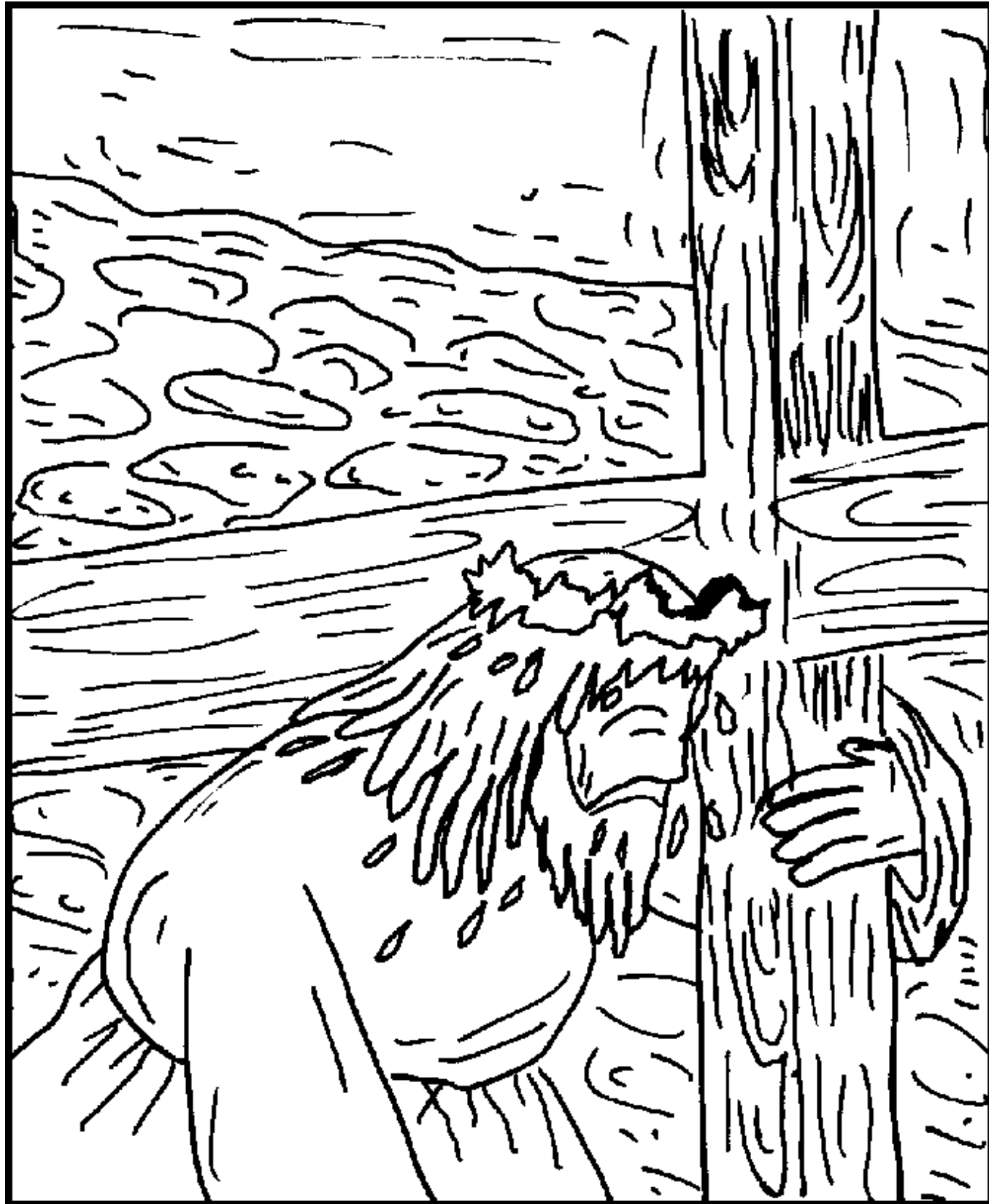
# Nails for our Sins     Luke 23:27-33

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.



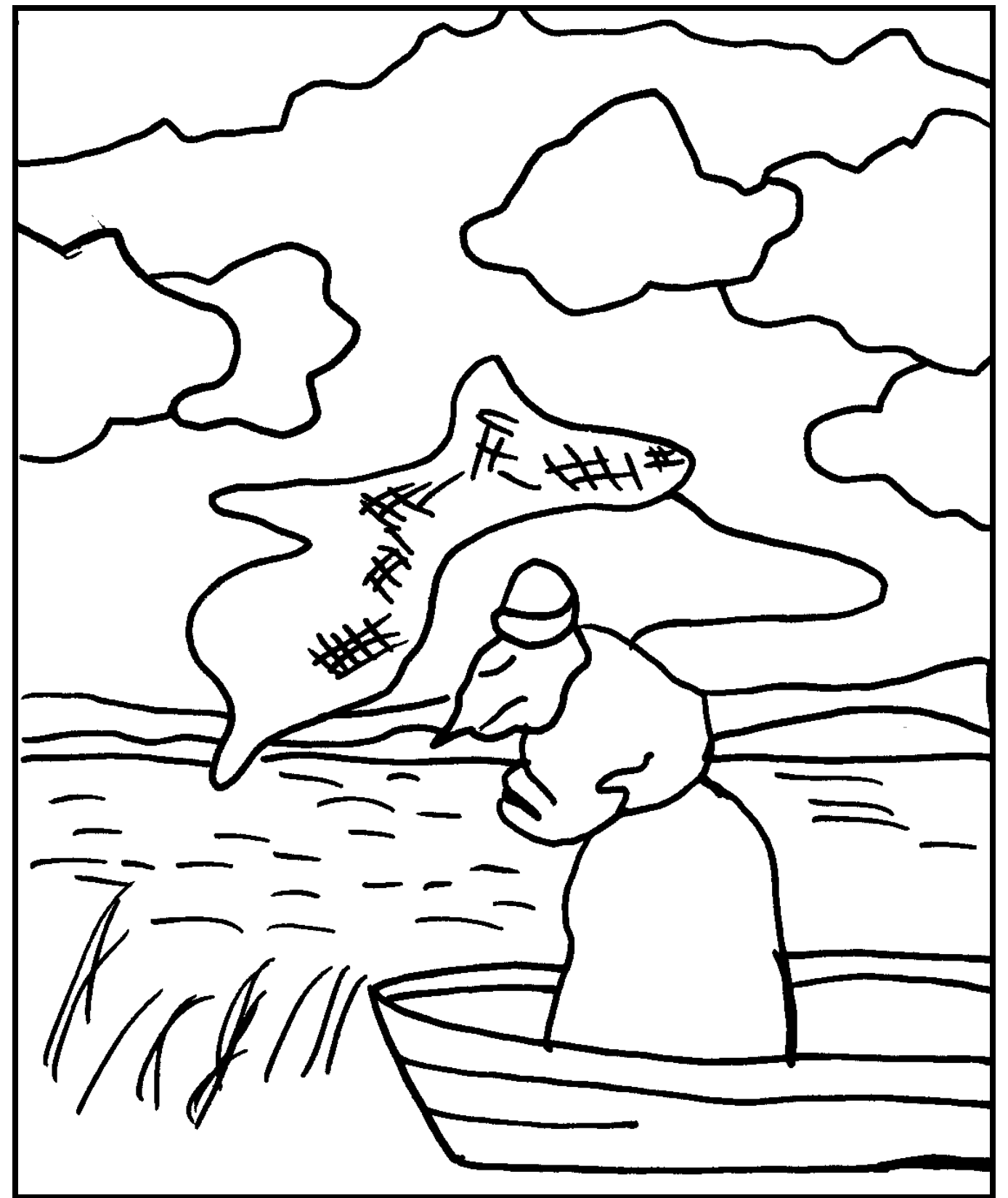
# Carrying the Cross      John 19:16-17

And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha.



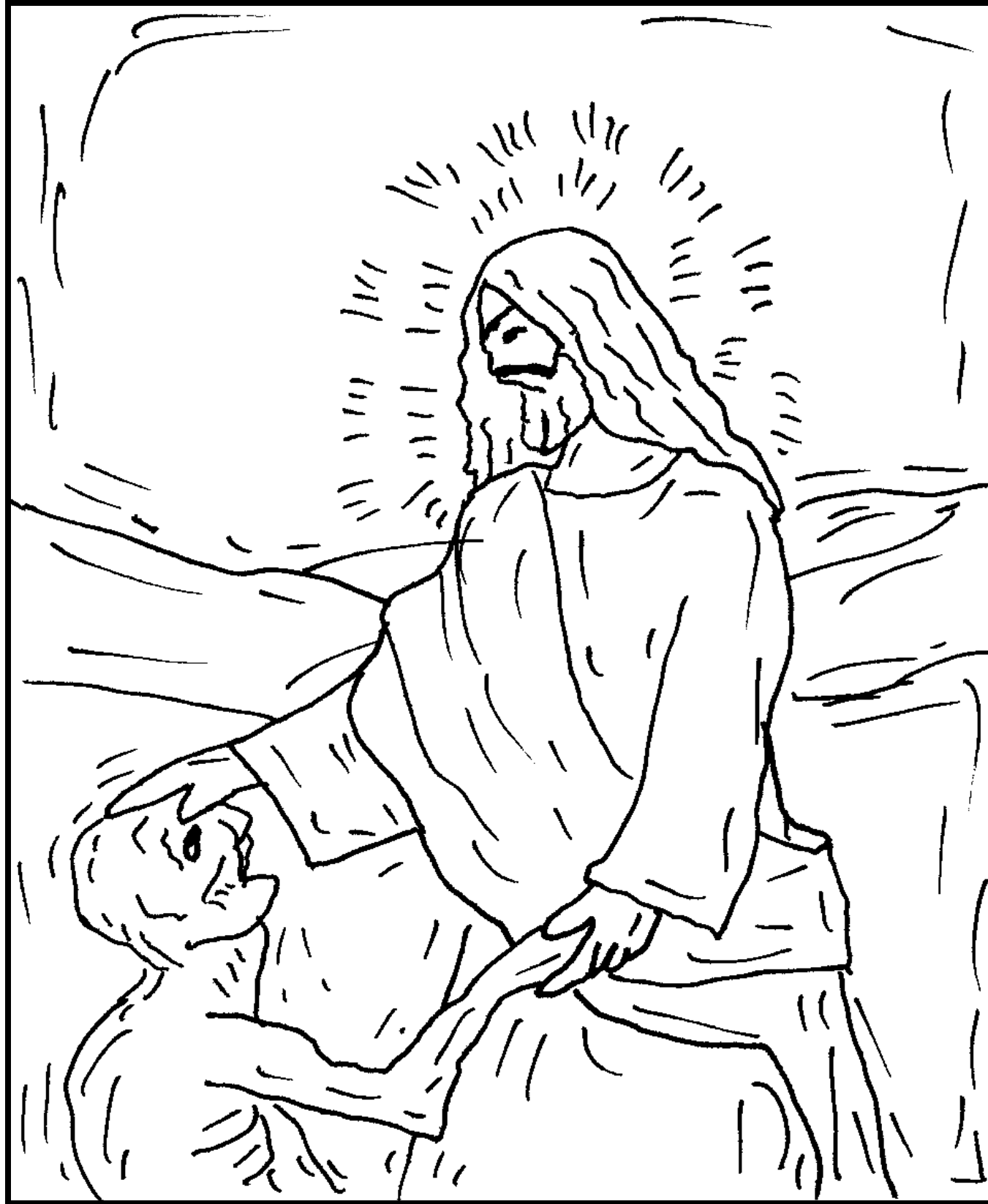
# Fishers of Men      Mark 1:16-20

And Jesus said unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you to become fishers of men. And straightway they forsook their nets, and followed him.



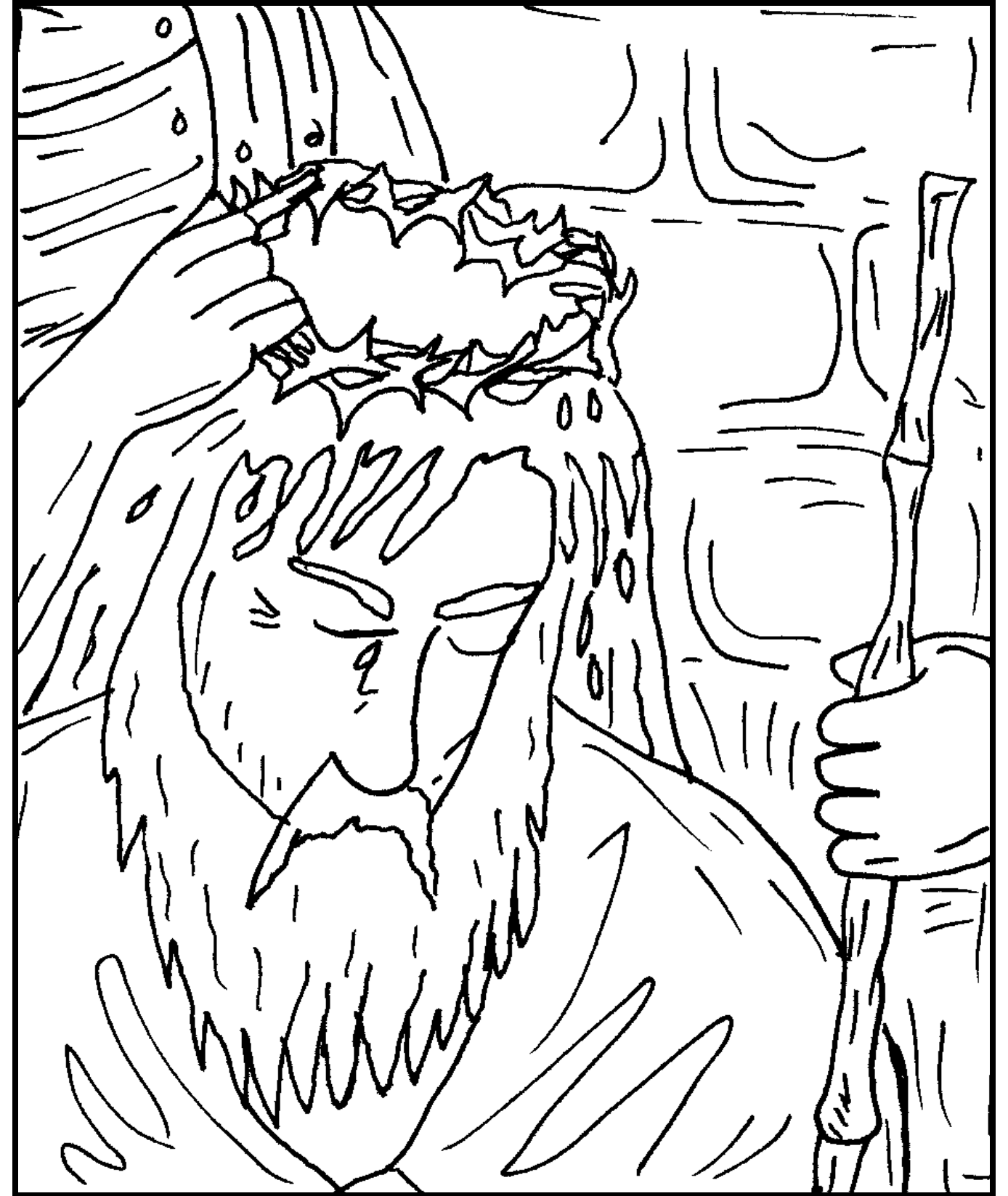
## Jesus Heals a Leper Mark 1:40-45

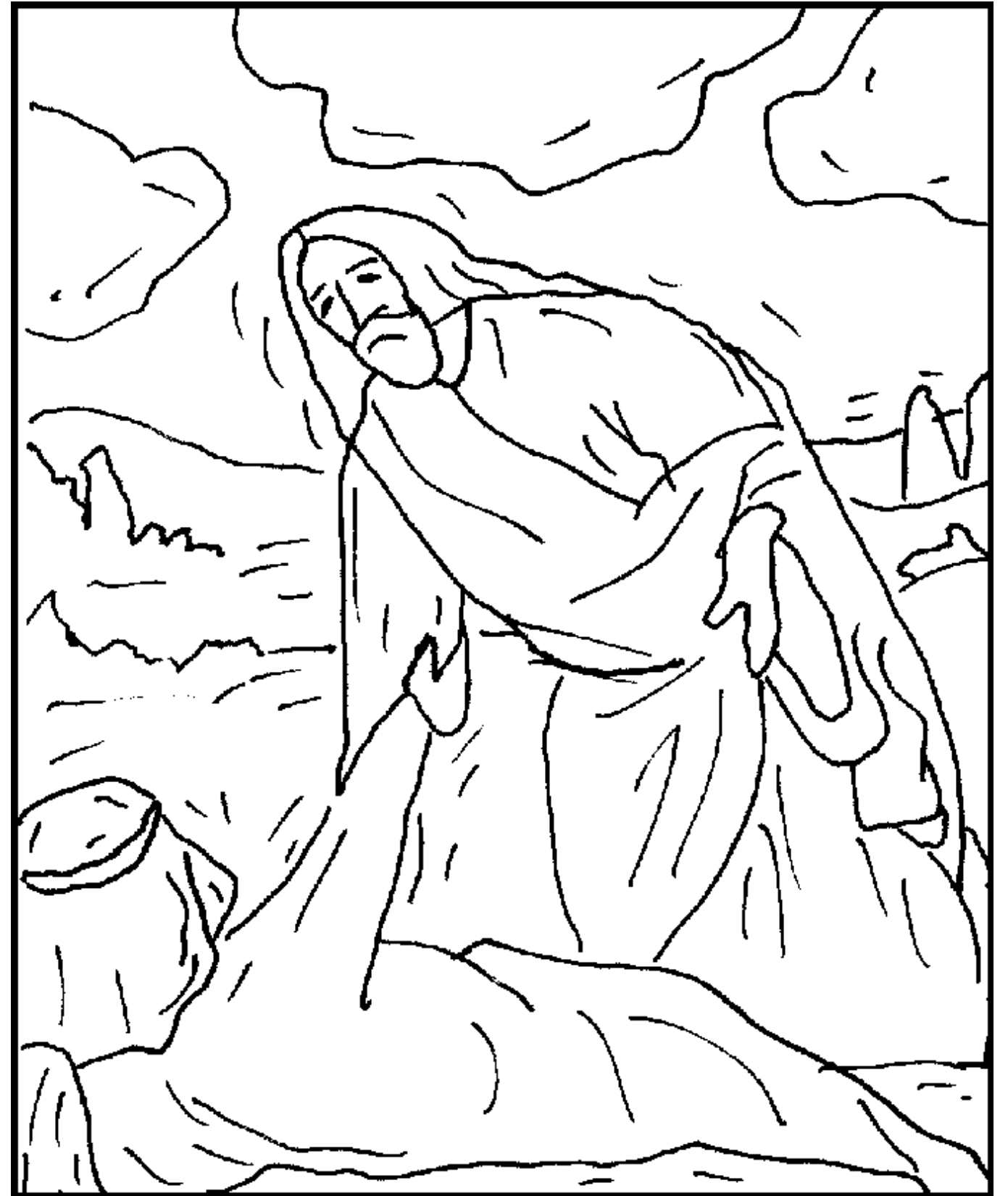
# Pontius Pilate Matthew 27:11-26

Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you, Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.



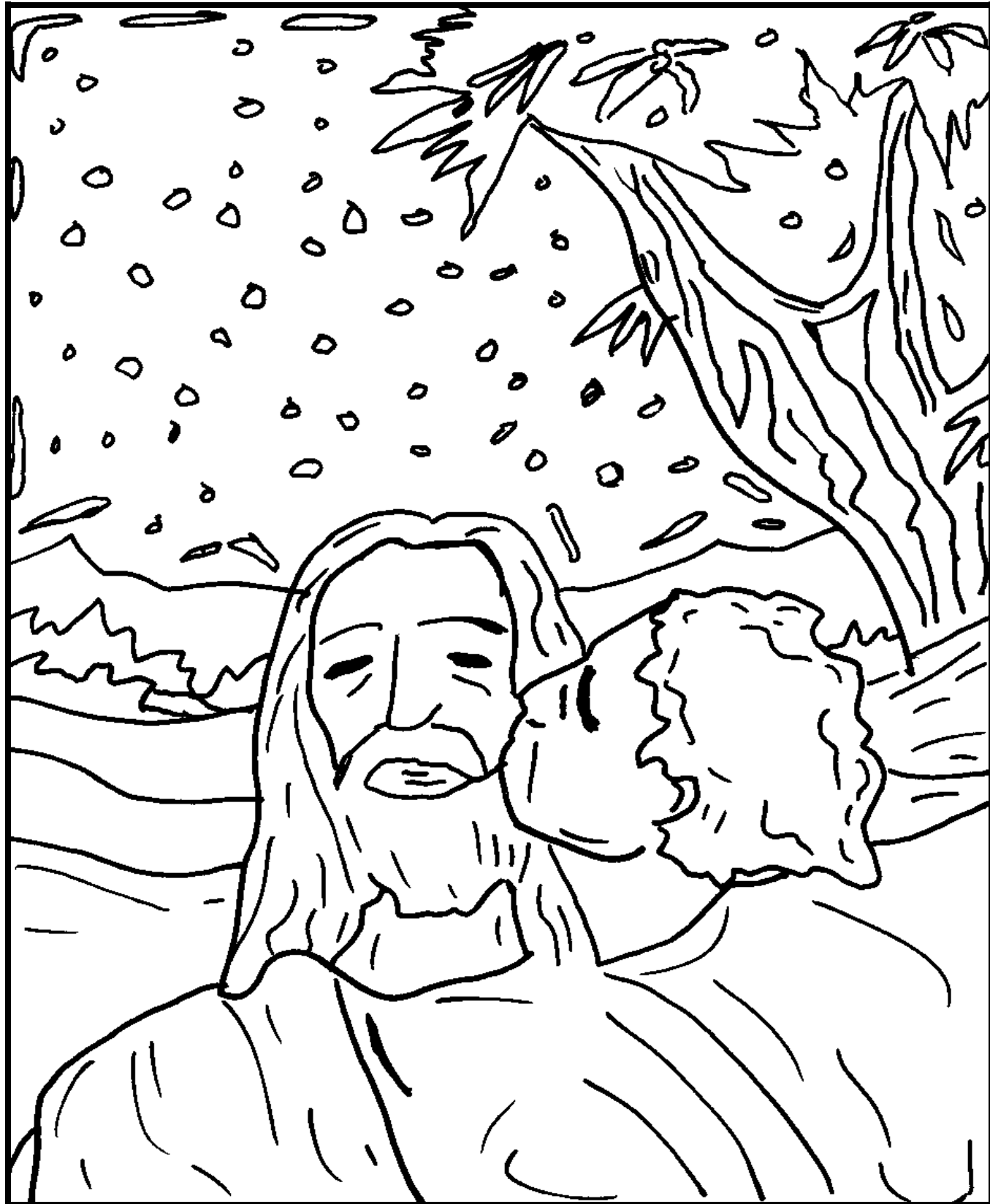

Abba, Father, all things are possible unto thee; take away this cup from me: nevertheless not what I will, but what thou wilt.



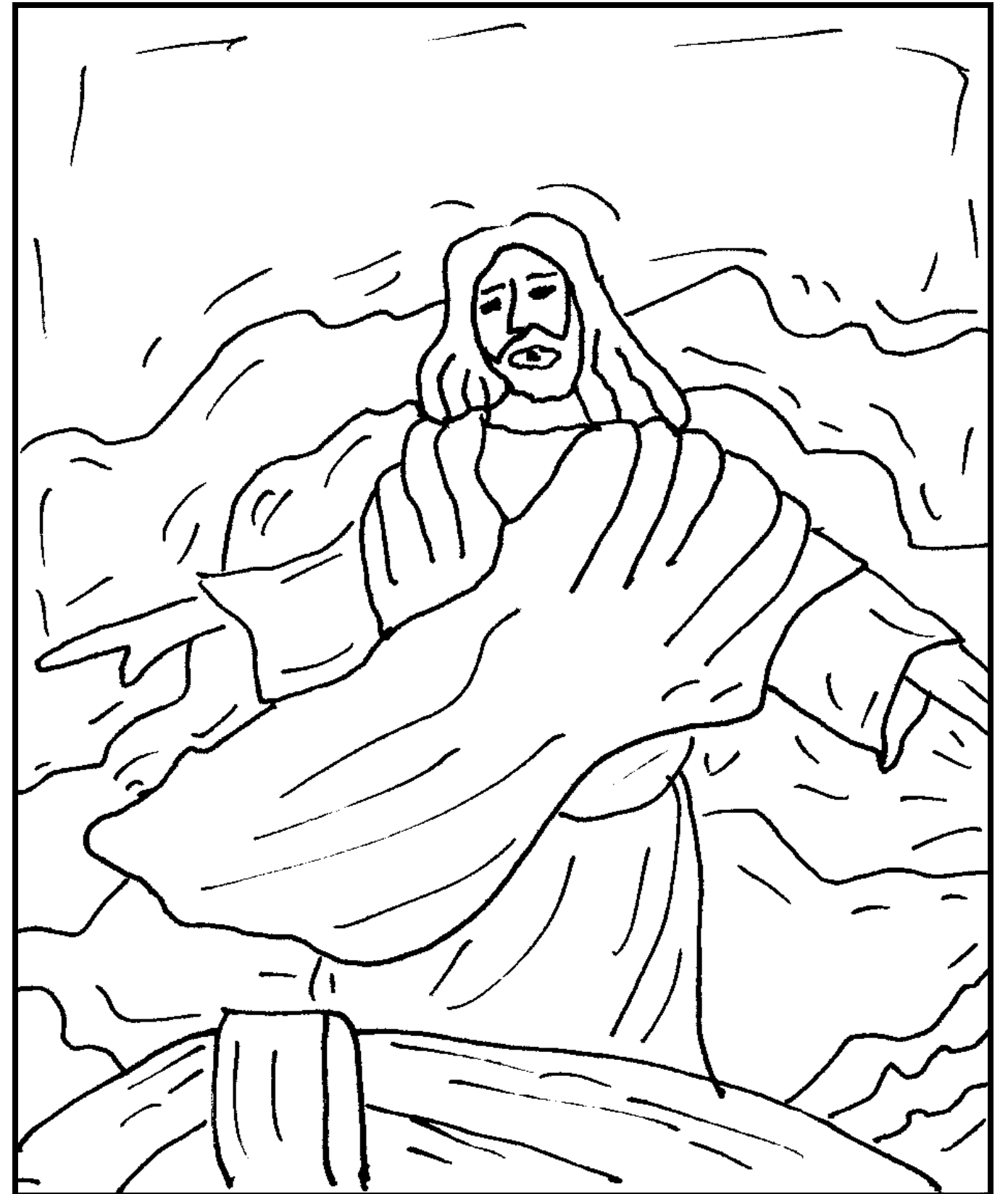

And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.



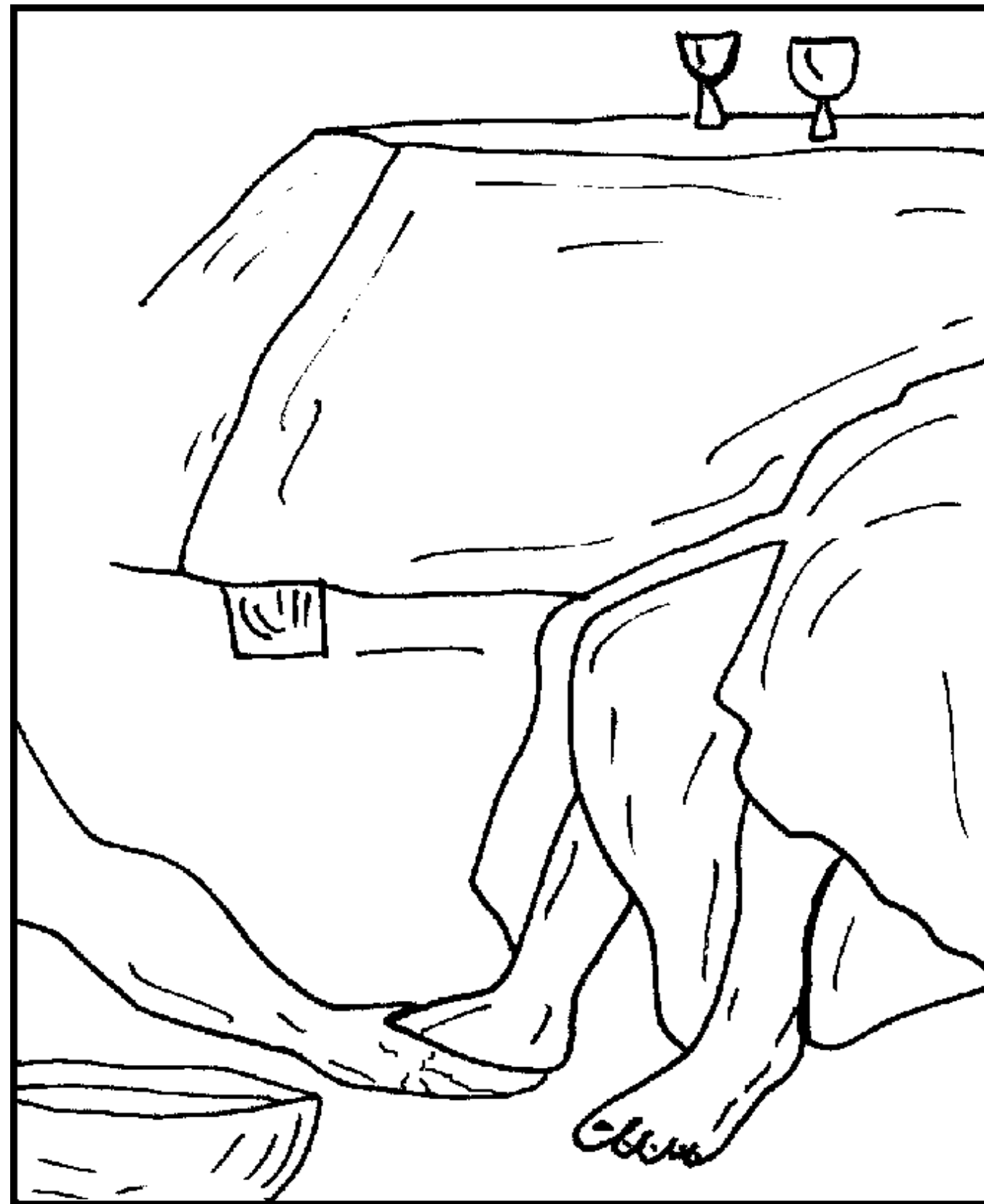
# Hem of His Garment     Mark 5:24-34

Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her.



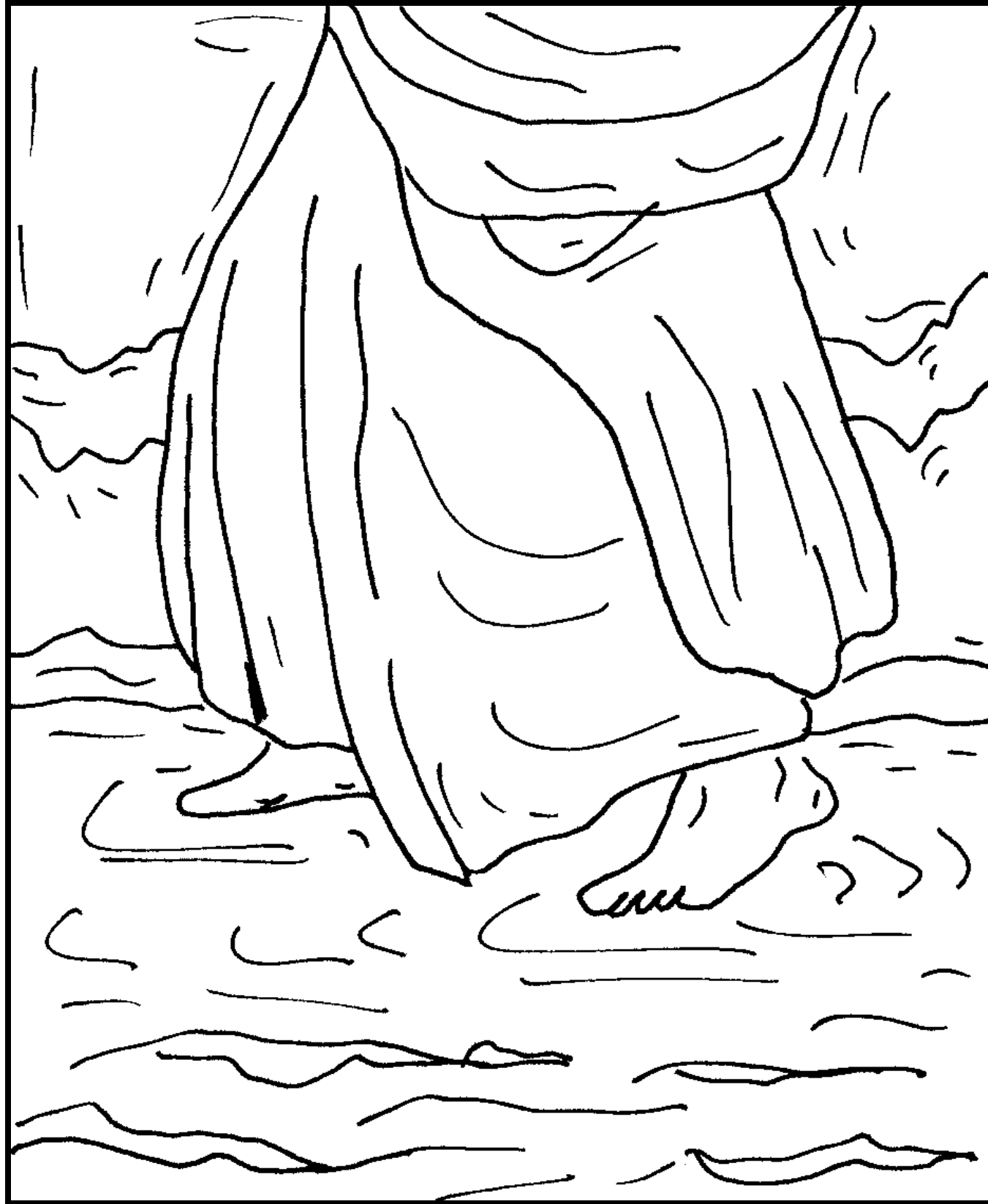

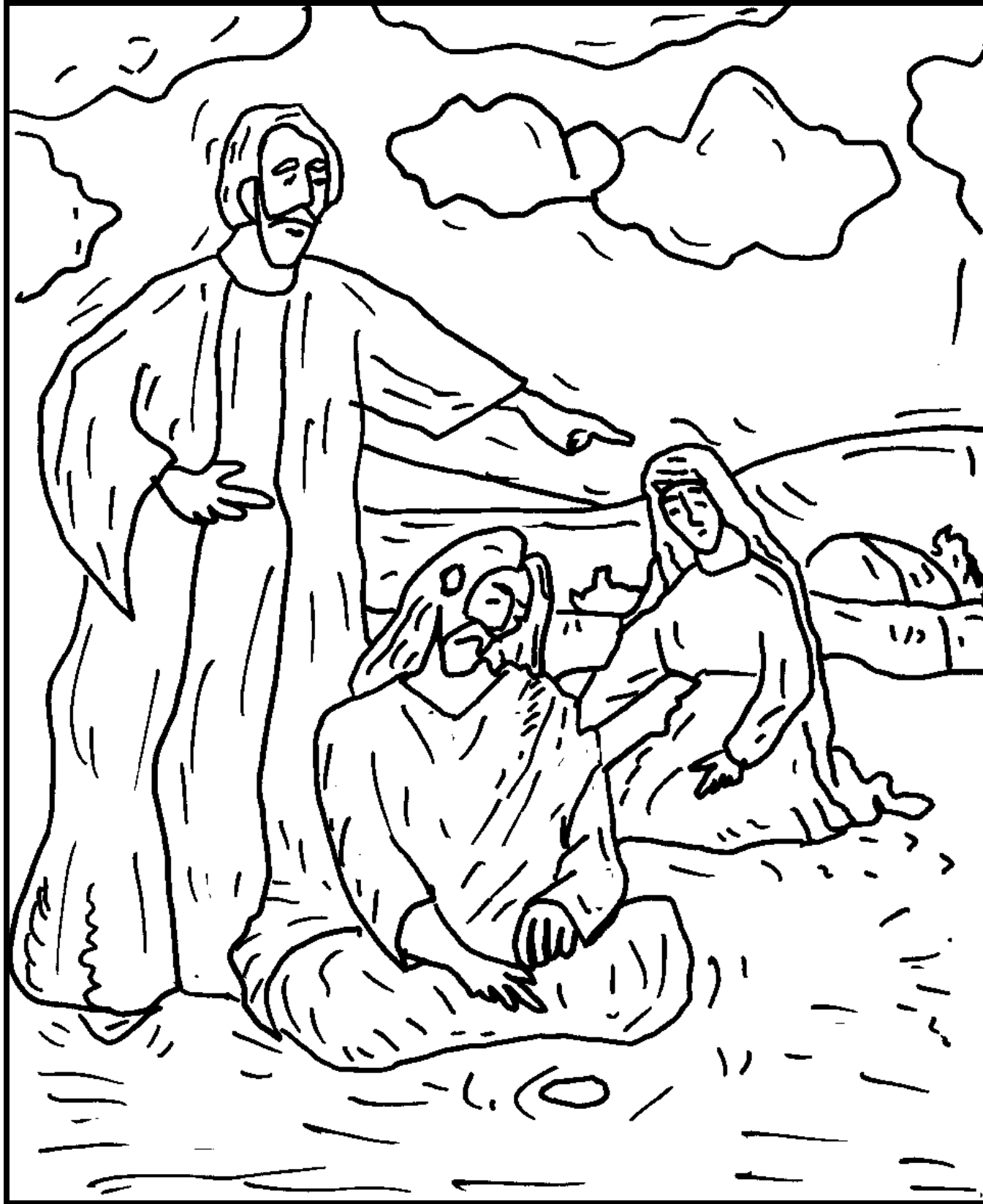
## Mt. of Transfiguration Luke 1:11-20

He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.



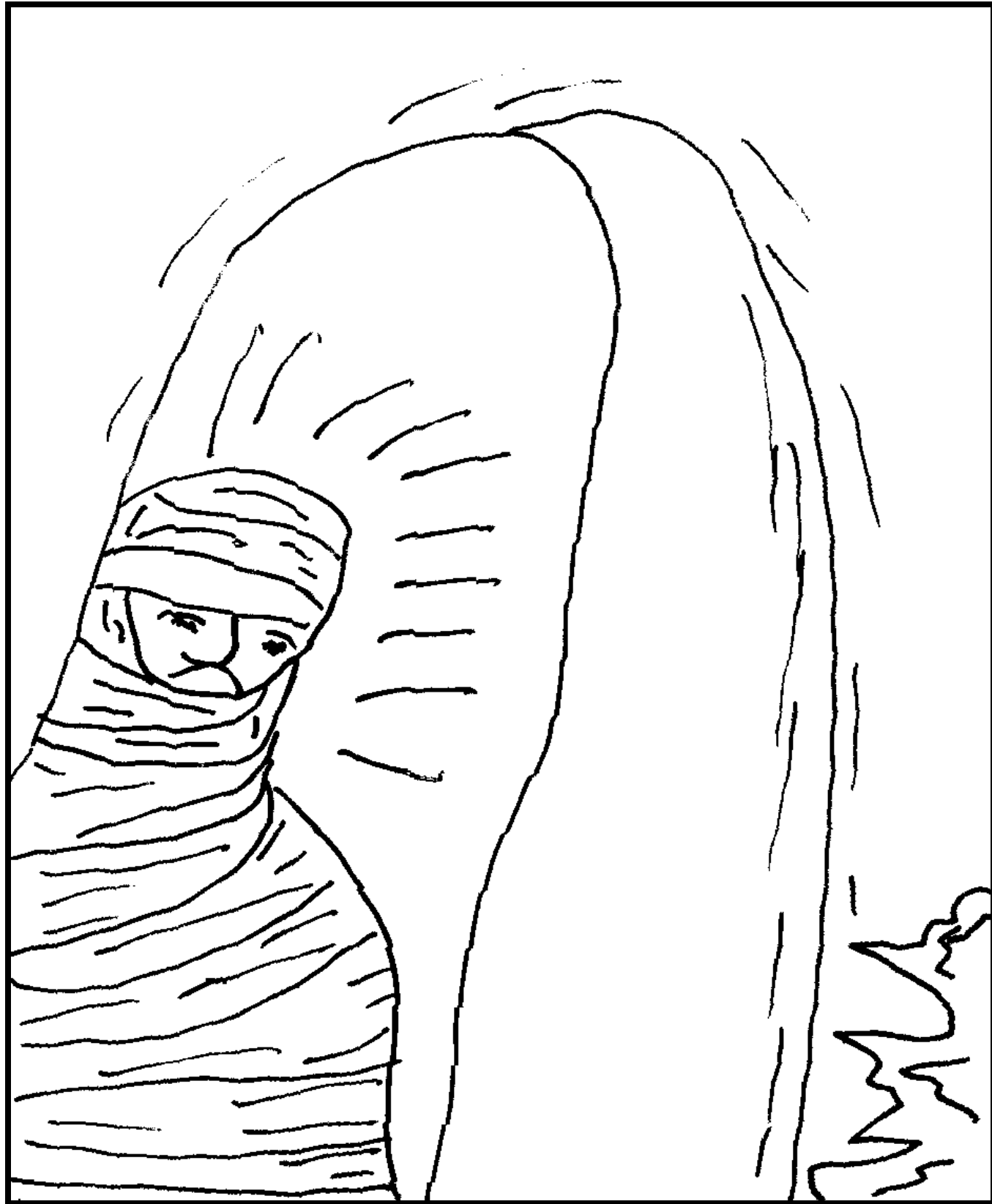
