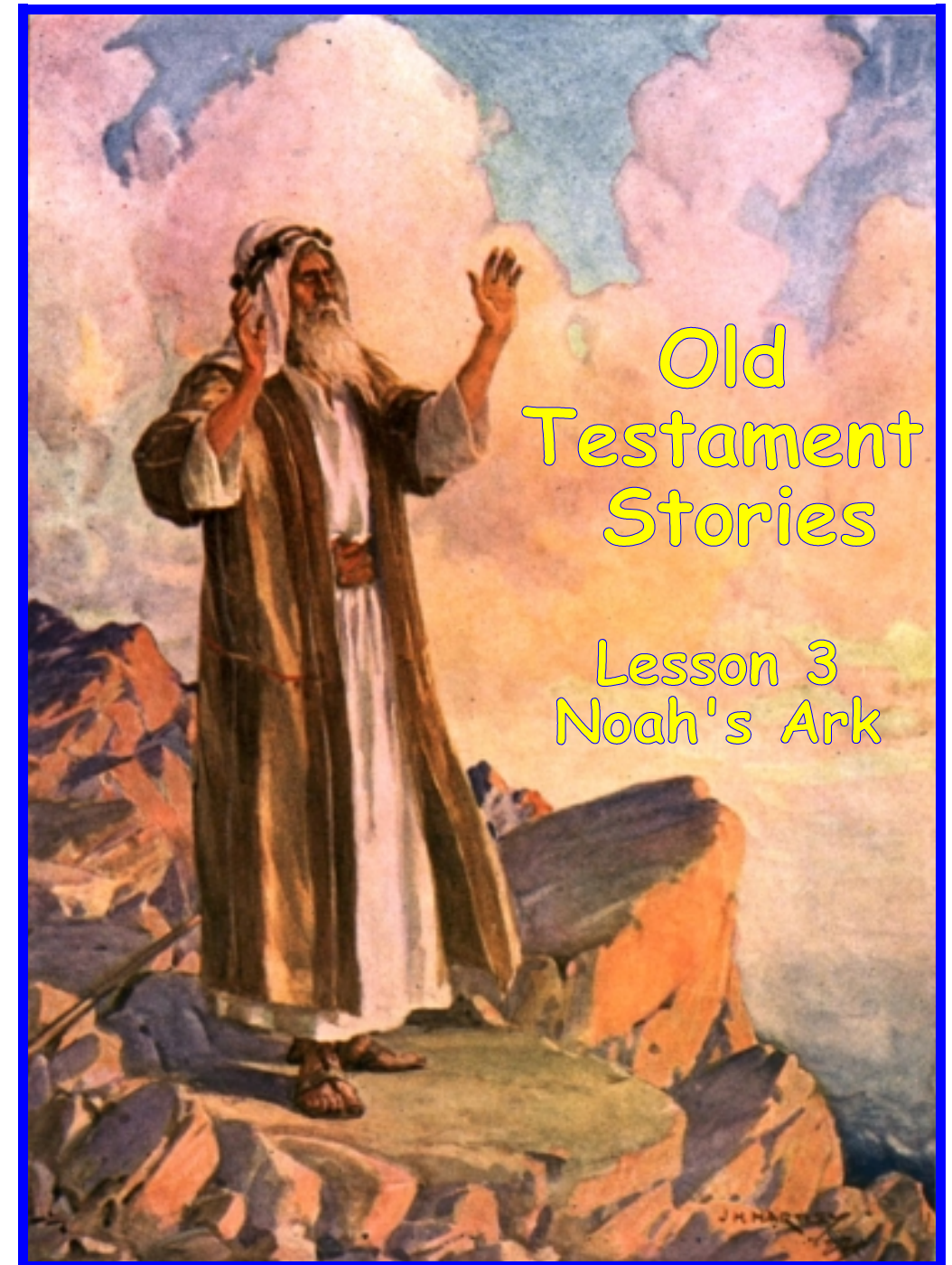
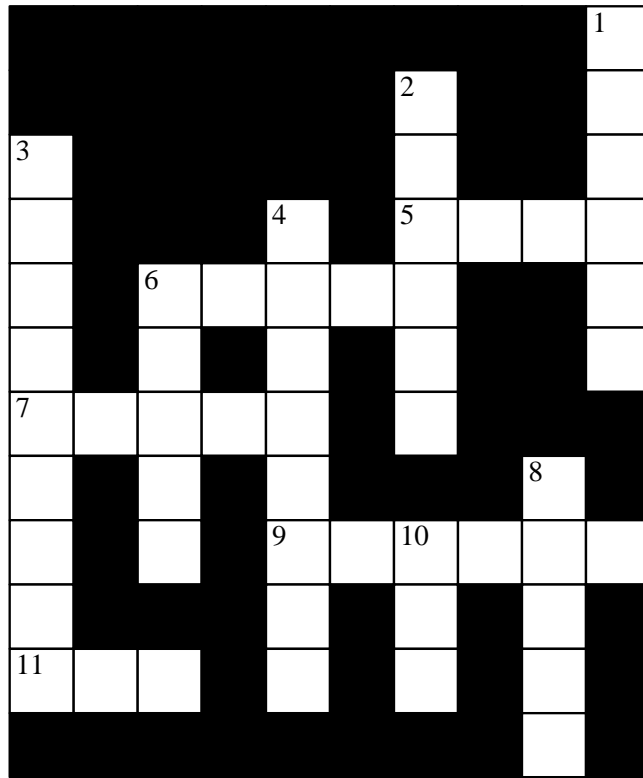

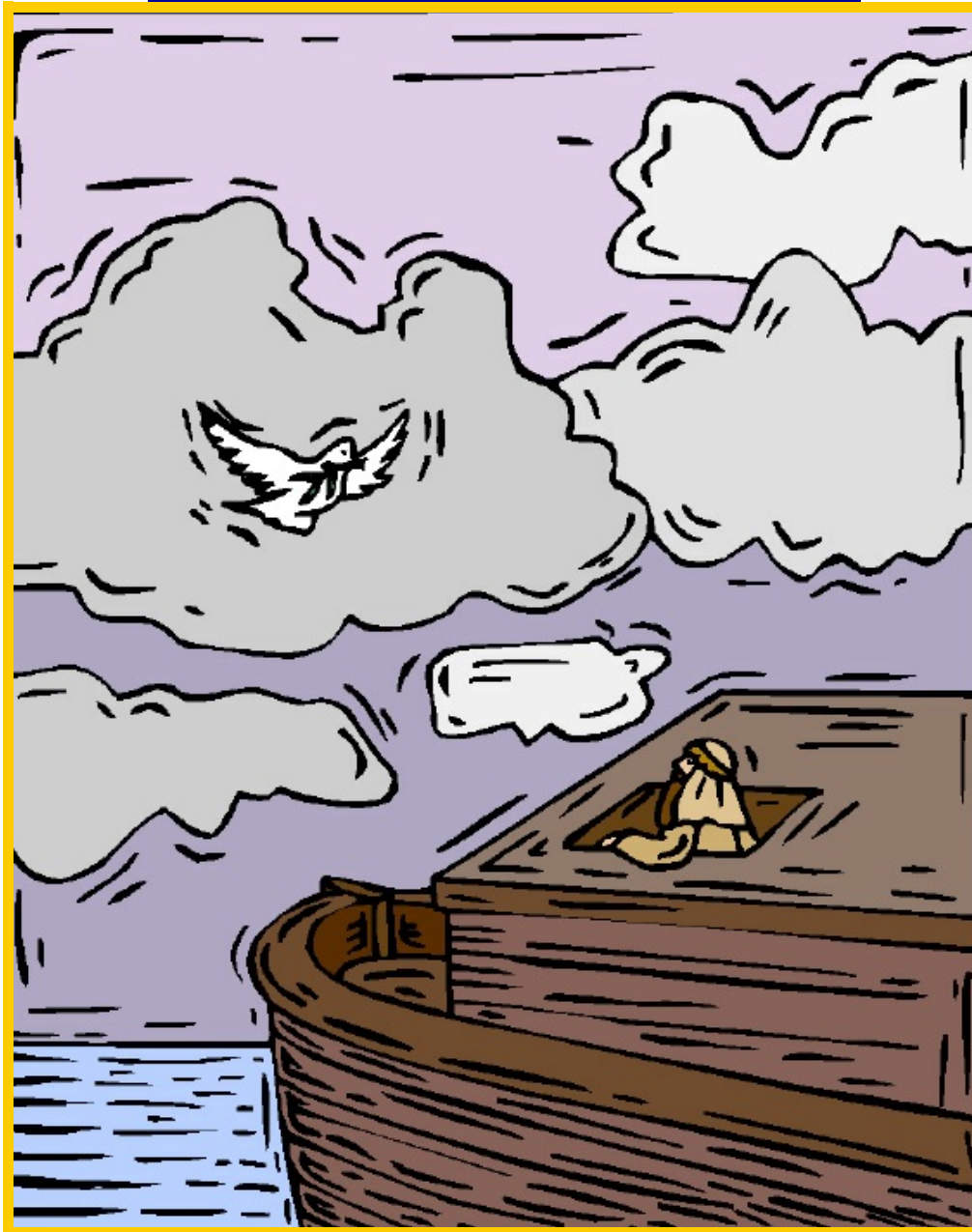

Genesis 6:1-8:5



1 And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,

2 That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

3 And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

Devotional

Noah's Ark

Once again we find God's children going against what God had told them. They were marrying, the Bible says, "daughters of men", those outside of a covenant and a relationship of God because they saw them as something beautiful to look upon.

We ourselves must be very careful of this when choosing a marriage partner. The bible says, "for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart." (1 Samuel 16-7) and also Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness?(2 Corinthians 6:14) We must choose our wives and our husbands based upon what the Lord wants and how pure our partners hearts are toward the Lord.

You see as time went on these families became more unrighteous, that even the sons of God had become evil and the wickedness of their hearts so much hurt God in His heart that he said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth". And he was sorry that he had ever made man.

Can we hurt God in his heart? Yes we can, it's called sin, and when we sin against God's Word, and go our own way, or do our own thing, God does feel it

in His heart. What do we do when we sin and hurt the heart of God?

There was a man named Noah, who found grace in God's sight. God said that Noah was just, and perfect and that he walked with God. God told Noah to build an ark to save his family and the animals of the earth. Even with the other people making fun of him the Bible says that, "Noah did according unto all that the LORD commanded him."

Well the day came when this flood God had promised came and it rained, and lifted up the ark. 40 days and 40 night it rained, until all the mountains were covered, and all living things had perished. Only Noah and those in the ark remained. The waters remained upon the earth 150 days and then began to recede, and the ark came to rest upon the mountains of Ararat.

Like Noah we should all strive to walk perfectly before God, but the Bible says, "For **all** have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23) We must confess our sin to God, trusting in the sacrifice, God gave for us, His only Son Jesus crucified on the cross, will pay our sin debt in full. And we must repent (turn around) and do our best to sin no more, walking and talking with God, careful to do all that the Lord commands us.

There is an ark for us today, and that ark is Jesus!
