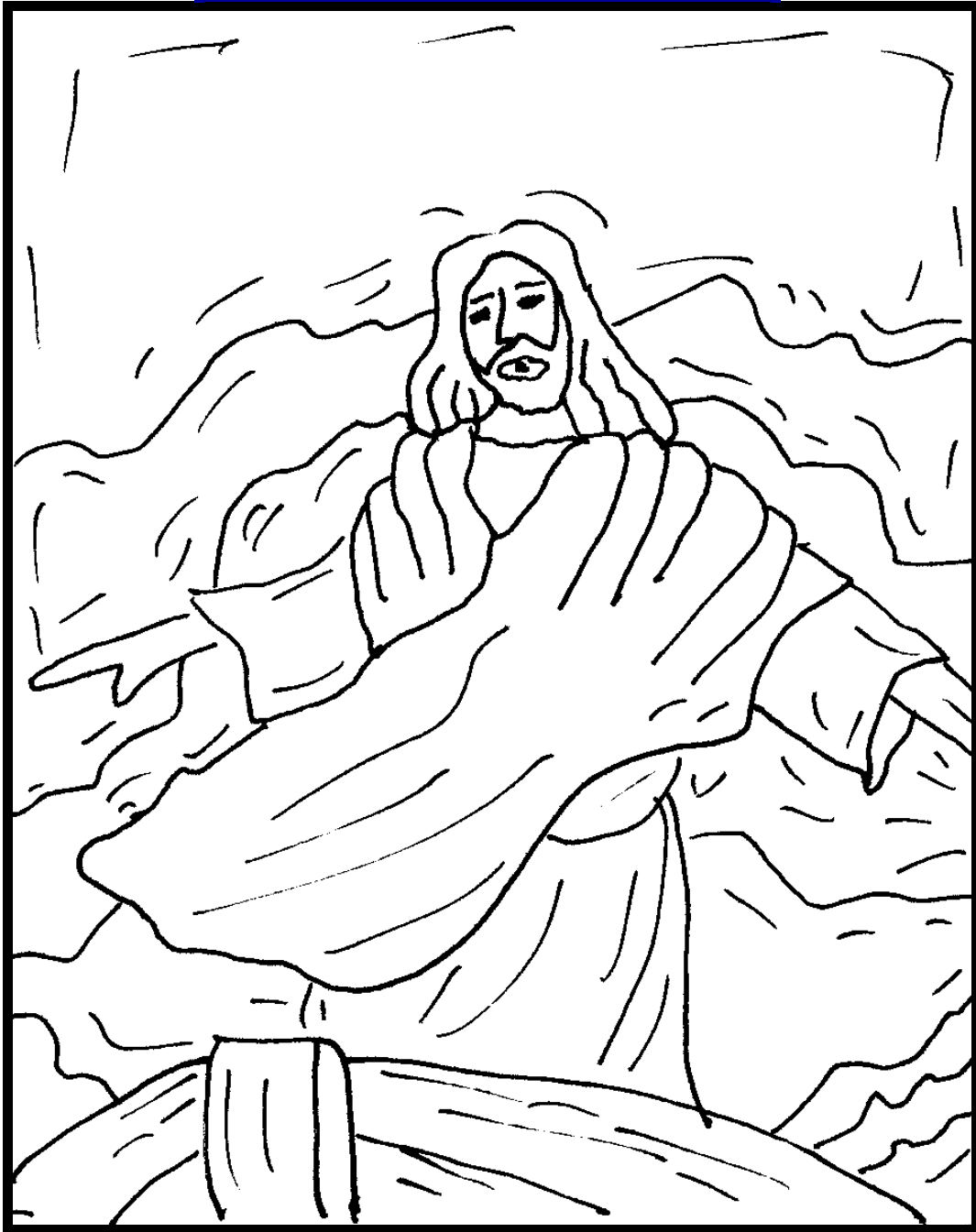

Sea of Galilee



Mentioned in the Bible under three other names. (1.) In the Old Testament it is called the "sea of Chinnereth" (Num. 34:11; Josh. 12:3; 13:27), as is supposed from its harp-like shape. (2.) The "lake of Genesareth" once by Luke (5:1), from the flat district lying on its west coast. (3.) John (6:1; 21:1) calls it the "sea of Tiberias" (q. v.). The modern Ar-

abs retain this name, Bahr Tabariyeh. This lake is 12 1/2 miles long, and from 4 to 7 1/2 broad. Its surface is 682 feet below the level of the Mediterranean. Its depth is from 80 to 160 feet. It is 27 miles east of the Mediterranean, and about 60 miles north-east of Jerusalem. It is of an oval shape, and abounds in fish. This sea is chiefly of interest as associated with the public ministry of our Lord. Capernaum, "his own city" (Matt. 9:1), stood on its shores. From among the fishermen who plied their calling on its waters he chose Peter and his brother Andrew, and James and John, to be disciples, and sent them forth to be "fishers of men" (Matt. 4:18,22; Mark 1:16-20; Luke 5: 1-11). He stilled its tempest, saying to the storm that swept over it, "Peace, be still" (Matt. 8:23-27; Mark 7:31-35); and here also he showed himself after his resurrection to his disciples (John 21). "The Sea of Galilee is indeed the cradle of the gospel. And this large and varied population, with access to all nations and countries, attracted the Lord Jesus, and induced him to make this spot the center of his public ministry."

PEACE BE STILL

Matt. 8:23 Then he got into the boat and his disciples followed him. NIV

Jesus wanted to go to Gadara. He could have walked there on solid ground. That would have been the safest way to go. But he got into a boat and crossed the Tiberias Lake. The Bible said that the disciples followed Him.

Matt. 8:24 Without warning, a furious storm came up on the lake, so that the waves swept over the boat. But Jesus was sleeping. NIV

This was no normal storm. Remember many of the disciples were fishermen they lived on the sea. In their life time they had experienced many storms. But this one made them afraid. This storm was made by Satan because he wanted to kill Jesus and His disciples. He wanted to stop God's work here on earth. Jesus was not worried he continued to sleep.

Matt. 8:25 The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" Niv

The disciples had Jesus with them but to them it seemed like He did not care about them. They became even more afraid. They ran and grabbed hold of Jesus.

You have Jesus with you today. If you have asked Him to forgive your sins and come into your heart.

There may be times you think He is not there or that He does not care about you. But He is there Closer than a brother and you can reach out to Him. Just call His name.

Matt 8:26 He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm. NIV Jesus was not angry with His disciples because they woke him up or asked Him to save them. He was angry because they did not trust Him. Jesus is always waiting for us to call His name and ask Him to save us.

Matt. 8:27 The men were amazed and asked, "What kind of man is this? Even

the winds and the waves obey him!" NIV.

Jesus proved that He had power over Satan and all of creation, the wind, the rain and even the seas. If we believe Jesus and trust Him we never need to be afraid. Jesus can calm all our storms.

Jesus wanted to teach his disciples and us a lesson about following Him and serving Him. Jesus wants us to trust Him, step out of our safe places and go do things that other people will not do. Most people want to go to heaven by dry land. They want to walk in safety not having people and Satan angry at them and trying to stop them by making fun of them and even trying to hurt or kill them. The true disciples of Jesus are willing to go to sea with Him. They will venture out on the dangerous sea trusting their Lord.

Have you ever watched the television program called Fear Factor. The contestants on that program will do many dangerous acts. They also do many crazy and stupid things like eating worms and bugs. They do it because they want to get a lot of money and a lot of attention, millions of people watching them.

Jesus is looking for young boys and girls today who will come out from behind the rocks and the trees on dry ground! Yes step out of your safety zone and step into the boat with Jesus, and sail out on the sea where every one can see them. Jesus wants you to be brave and stand up for what good! Be bold enough to say to your friends drugs are wrong. Drinking beer is bad. No I do not listen to that kind of music with all those swear words in the song. Sex is for marriage. Boys and Girls who talk like that are brave they are heroes.

Jesus also wants us to do things that appear foolish to most people. Like loving your enemy, Praying for people who hate you, doing good to those who do bad things to you, helping others especially the poor and kids that are not cool. That is sailing with Jesus!
