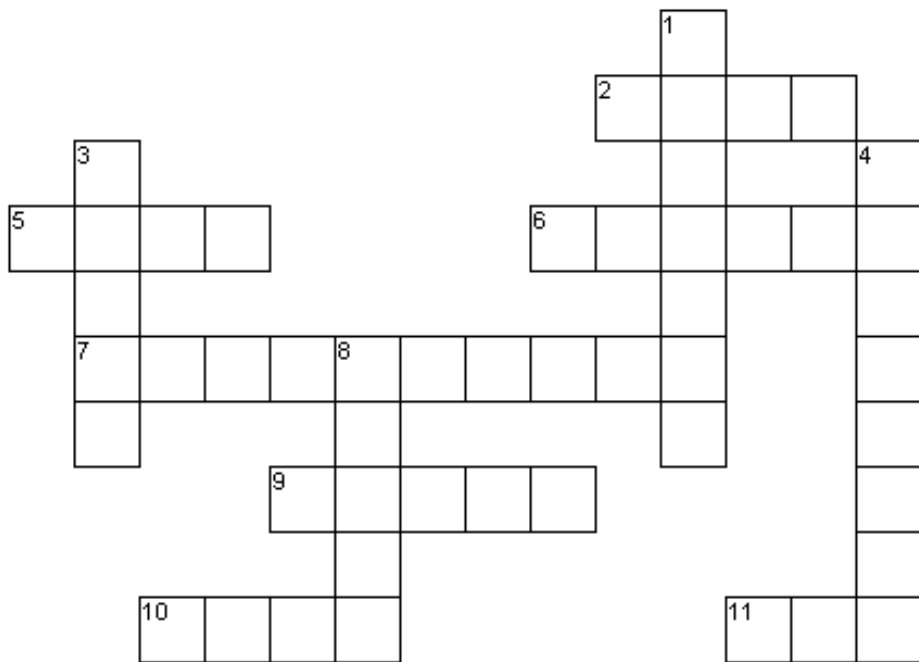

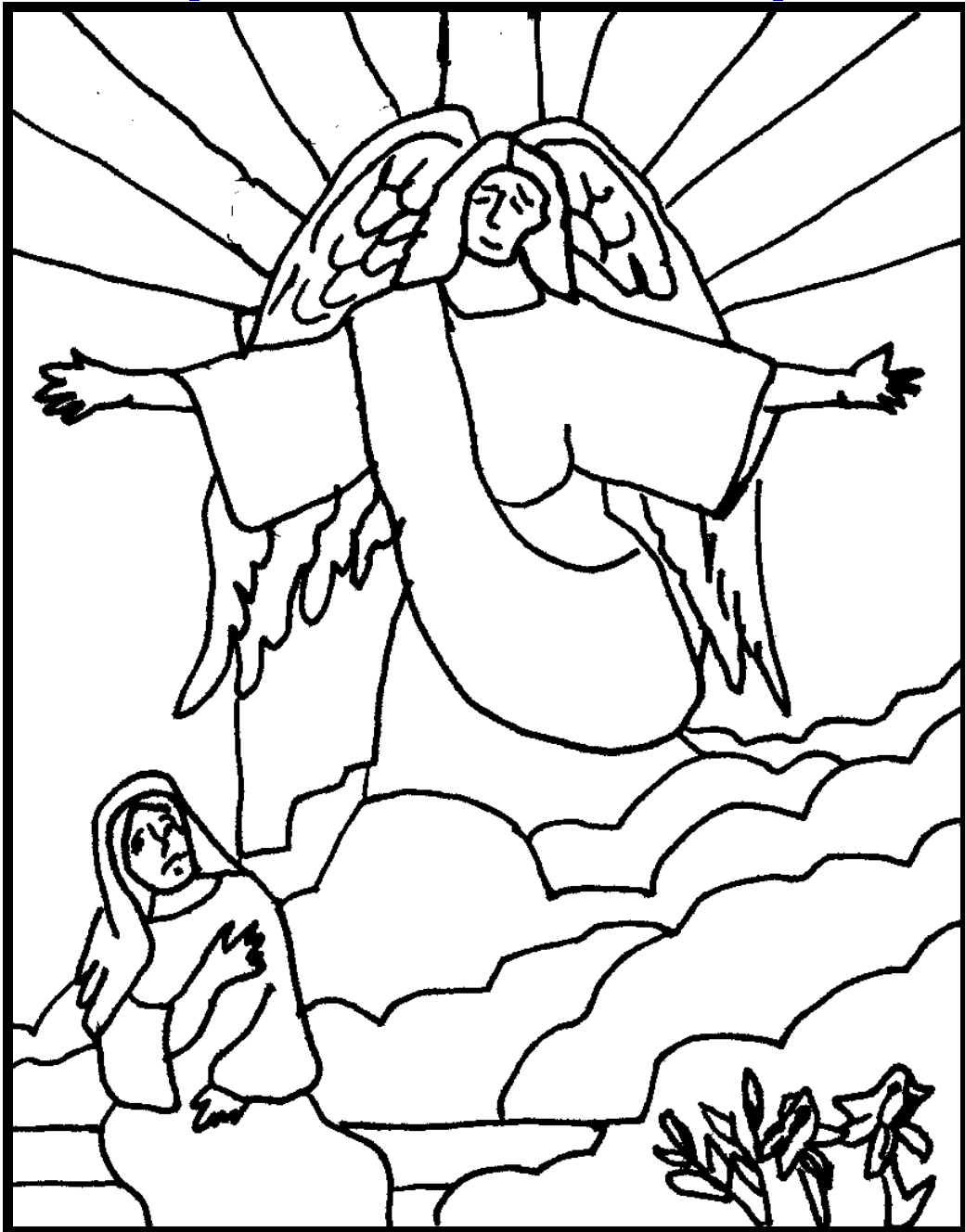

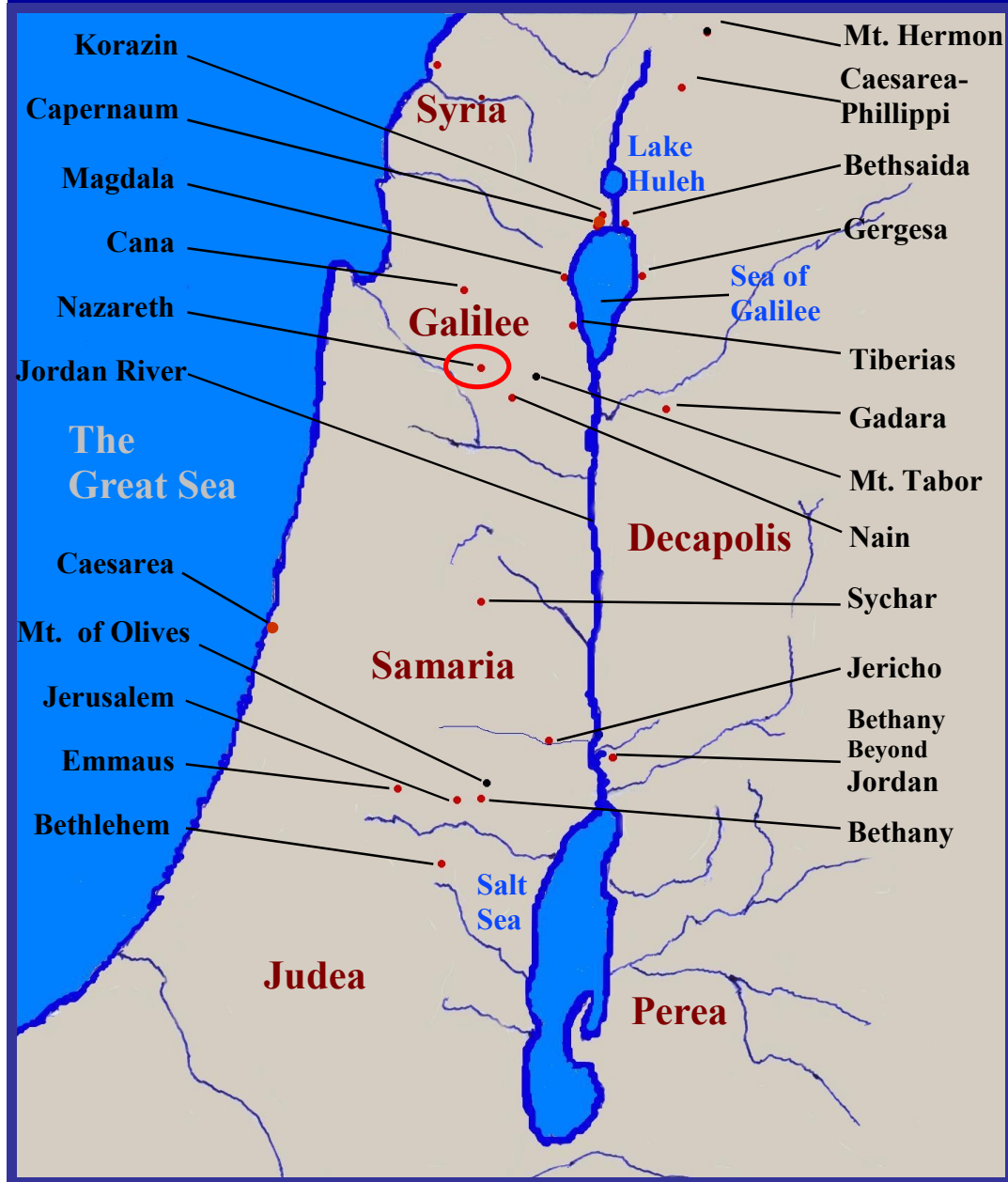

26 And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth, 27 To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. 28 And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. 29 And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. 30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. 31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. 32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: 33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. 34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man? 35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. 36 And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren. 37 For with God nothing shall be impossible. 38 And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word. Nazareth



This city is not mentioned in the Old Testament. It was the home of Joseph and Mary (Luke 2:39), and here the angel announced to the Virgin the birth of the Messiah (1:26-28). Here Jesus grew up from his infancy to manhood (4:16); and here he began his public ministry in the synagogue (Matt. 13:54), at which the people were so offended that they sought to cast him down from the precipice whereon their city was built (Luke 4:29). Twice they expelled him from their borders (4:16-29; Matt. 13:54-58); and he finally retired from the city, where he did not many mighty works because of their unbelief (Matt. 13:58), and took up his residence in Capernaum. Nazareth is situated among the southern ridges of Lebanon, on the steep slope of a hill, about 14 miles from the Sea of Galilee and about 6 west from Mount Tabor. It is identified with the modern village en-Nazirah. The name Nazareth perhaps means 'a watch tower' (now en-Nasrah), but is connected in the New Testament with Netzer, 'a branch' (Isa. 4:2; Jer. 23:5; Zech. 3:8; 6:12; Matt. 2:23), Nazarene being quite a different word from Nazarite."

Devotional

Wow, what a story. Gabriel coming down from heaven to visit Mary in Nazareth. He told her she was favored of God and blessed among women. Would you be afraid if this happened to you? Gabriel must have sensed she was afraid, then he began to tell her all that God had planned for her.

He told her she would have a son and that His name was to be Jesus, and that he was to be great, the Son of God. Mary asked how this would occur because she hadn't been with a man, and Gabriel told her that that the Holy Ghost would come upon her, and the power of the Highest would overshadow her. What a miracle, Mary a virgin, would give birth to the Son of God. No one else has or ever will be born like this.

Gabriel then tells of her cousin Elizabeth, who couldn't have children, was now in her sixth month. For with God nothing shall be impossible. Do you know Elizabeth's sons name?

Then Mary made a most astounding statement, Behold the handmade of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word. It seems amazing to me that Mary could have had such great faith based upon the little bit of information that Gabriel had given her.

What about Mary and Joseph's plans, yet Mary called herself the handmade of the Lord. To be a hand made is to be a servant, but more than a servant, a personal attendant. Always willing to do the will of the father.

Proverbs 3

5 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

What about your plans? What about your will? Do you seek the will of the father and set your hearts to place his will, his plan for your lives, before our own will or desires.

Let's take a look at Jesus and see what He did? Remember when he was twelve years old and He went to the feast at Jerusalem with Mary and Joseph. Mary thinking Jesus was with them left Jerusalem to go home only to find out a day later he was lost. She found Him in the synagogue amazing the rulers and scribes with his knowledge of the scriptures. When she question him about why he did this , he answered **“How is it that ye sought me? Don't you know that I must be about my Father's business?”**

Or more importantly , picture Jesus leaving Peter, James, and John, to go further into the Garden of Gethsemane to pray. Praying in desperation to the Father, to let this cup of death on the cross pass from him, but knowing the will of the father he prays,

Mark 14

36 And he said, Abba, Father, all things are possible unto thee; take away this cup from me: nevertheless not what I will, but what thou wilt.

With this decision to do God's will Jesus opened the door for me and you to be saved and have sweet communion with God the Father. Your decisions to do the will of God are just as important as the decision Jesus made that night in the Garden. Not only because they affect your life, but because they affect the lives of others around you.
