<sup>1</sup>And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples. <sup>2</sup>And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, **Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.** <sup>3</sup>**Give us day by day our daily bread.** <sup>4</sup>**And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.** <sup>5</sup>And he said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves; <sup>6</sup>For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? <sup>7</sup>And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee. <sup>8</sup>I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth. <sup>9</sup>And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. <sup>10</sup>For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. <sup>11</sup>If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if *he ask* a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? <sup>12</sup>Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? <sup>13</sup>If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

## Prayer

is conversing with God; the communion of the soul with God, not in contemplation or meditation, but in direct address to him. Prayer may be oral or mental, occasional or constant, casual or formal. It is a "beseeching the Lord" (Ex. 32:11); "pouring out the soul before the Lord" (1 Sam. 1:15); "praying and crying to heaven" (2 Chr. 32:20); "seeking unto God and making supplication" (Job 8:5); "drawing near to God" (Ps. 73:28); "bowing the knees" (Eph. 3:14).

Prayer presupposes a belief in the personality of God, his ability and willingness to hold intercourse with us, his personal control of all things and of all his creatures and all their actions.

Acceptable prayer must be sincere (Heb. 10:22), offered with reverence and godly fear, with a humble sense of our own insignificance as creatures and of our own unworthiness as sinners, with earnest importunity, and with unhesitating submission to the divine will. Prayer must also be offered in the faith that God is, and is the hearer and answerer of prayer, and that he will fulfil his word, "Ask, and ye shall receive" (Matt. 7:7, 8; 21:22; Mark 11:24; John 14:13, 14), and in the name of Christ (16:23, 24; 15:16; Eph. 2:18; 5:20; Col. 3:17; 1 Pet. 2:5).

### **How Should We Pray?**

How should we pray? Now that's a good question! Jesus was always giving Himself to the practice of prayer. In the first part of this story, one disciple noticed and asked Jesus, "Teach us to pray, Lord.

This was a good request and showed an eagerness to learn a holy habit. Jesus was so unselfish to act this way and His lifestyle attracted others. This is what the disciples asked, " Give us your secret, tell us how we may do the things you do, and become more like you." They noticed that Jesus was in touch with the Father, that he had communion with the Father through prayer.

The Lord's Prayer - was given to us as a model prayer at that time. Since you are speaking to Father God desire to hallow his name. Give Him praise and honor and glory as you place Him first in your life.

Recognizing He is not just first in your life, but He rules and reigns supreme over all the earth, and all the people of the earth. Pray that His will be done over your

life and the lives of others.

Knowing that God is concerned over your physical needs also, one should ask God in faith believing that whatever we ask of Him according to His will we will receive.

Realize that He sent his one and only Son to die for your sin, that's much He loves us! This should serve as an example of how we should forgive others when they sin against us.

We should also ask that Jesus help us in our times of temptation, and we should not rely on our own abilities. We should also ask that Jesus protect us from the enemy, the devil, who prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

Most importantly do not be selfish, but look on the needs of others, remembering them, then your needs will fall into place, and you will be led by God as His special child with His purposes for your life.
