house of dates. (1.) The Revised Version in John 1:28 has this word instead of Bethabara, on the authority of the oldest manuscripts. It appears to have been the name of a place on the east of Jordan. (2.) A village on the south-eastern slope of the Mount of Olives

(Mark 11:1), about 2 miles east of Jerusalem, on the road to Jericho. It derived its name from the number of palm-trees which grew there. It was the residence of Lazarus and his sisters. It is frequently mentioned in connection with memorable incidents in the life of our Lord (Matt. 21:17; 26:6; Mark 11:11, 12; 14:3; Luke 24:50; John 11:1; 12:1). It is now known by the name of el-Azariyeh, i.e., "place of Lazarus," or simply Lazariyeh. Seen from a distance, the village has been described as "remarkably beautiful, the perfection of retirement and repose, of seclusion and lovely peace." Now a mean village, containing about twenty families.

## Devotional

### Jesus gives Understanding

There are so many people in this world who do not know Jesus and why they should serve him. “My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge,” states Hosea 4:6. Unless we give our lives to Jesus, accept Him as our Lord and Savior, we will never understand His ways. I Cor. 15:34 states, “Come back to your senses as you ought, and stop sinning; for there are some who are ignorant (lacking in knowledge) of God... I say this to your shame.”

Once we are saved, He will give us wisdom, knowledge, and understanding through reading the Bible . I Timothy 2:4 states, Jesus, “wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.” Jesus tells us that it is the Holy Spirit that leads us to know the truth, and that it is also the Holy Spirit (**I send the promise of my Father upon you**) that gives us the power to tell others about Jesus and what he has done for us. We are his witnesses!
